

**551.** On the occasion of 'World Water Day', National Mission for Clean Ganga (NMCG), UNESCO and other partners released three animation films under its initiative "H2Ooooh! - Waterwise program for the Children of India". The initiative was launched by UNESCO along with the NMCG and others in July 2021. {Read more}

**552.** On March 28, Delhi Deputy Chief Minister Manish Sisodia presented a Rs 75,800 Cr 'Rozgar budget' for 2022-23 for Delhi with a 5-year plan to create 20 lakh jobs. The budget size of 2022-23 is 9.86% higher than that of 2021-22 which was called the 'Deshbhakti' (patriotism) budget by the Kejriwal government. An artificial intelligence-based website and a mobile application, "Rozgar Bazaar 2.0", will be launched with an aim to provide at least 1 lakh jobs every year to the youngsters of Delhi, especially women. {Read more}

553. On March 26, the Central Government (Department of Revenue, Ministry of Finance), on the basis of the recommendations of the Directorate General of Trade Remedies (DGTR), under Department of Commerce, has imposed anti-dumping duty for 5 years on 5 Chinese products - certain flat rolled products of aluminium, sodium hydrosulphite, silicone sealant, hydrofluorocarbon (HFC) component R-32 and hydrofluorocarbon blends. Apart from these five products, the DGTR recommended imposition of anti-dumping duty on other products originating in or exported from China PR in 2021-22. {Read more}

**554.** On March 25, the Meghalaya Enterprise Architecture (MeghEA) project to improve Governance and Service Delivery at the grassroots level in the state was nominated for the UN Awards in the World Summit on the Information Society Forum 2022. The MeghEA was nominated under the category of 'The role of governments and all stakeholders in the promotion of ICTs for development'. On March 25, the Governments of Delhi, Haryana, Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh of NCR signed a Combined Reciprocal Common Transport Agreements (CRCTA) covering both Contract Carriage & Stage Carriage since time period of earlier Agreements of Reciprocal Common Transport Agreement was coming to an end. The CRCTA shall come into force with immediate effect, for ensuring seamless movement of passenger vehicles in NCR and will be valid for next 10 years. {Read more}

The Bucharest Nine or Bucharest Format, often abbreviated as the B9, was founded on November 4, 2015, and takes its name from Bucharest, the capital of Romania. The group was created on the initiative of Klaus Iohannis, who has been President of Romania since 2014, and Andrzej Duda, who became President of Poland in August 2015. The B9 include Romania, Poland, Hungary, Bulgaria, Czech Republic, Slovakia, Estonia, Latvia, and Lithuania. {Read more}

The Czech National Bank won this year's Transparency award. Moreover, Wenxin Du won this year's award for Economics in Central Banking. {Read more}

565. On March 24, the World Bank priced the world's first wildlife bond called "RhinoBond", raising \$150 million that will be partly used for the conservation of black rhinos in South Africa. The five-year bond will pay returns determined by the rate of growth in populations of the animals in two South African reserves, the Addo Elephant National Park and the Great Fish River Nature Reserve. The Wildlife Conservation Bond is a first-of-its-kind, outcome-based, financial instrument that channels investments to achieve conservation outcomes. The bond was sold at 94.8% of its "nominal aggregate amount" and will pay out a maximum success payment of \$13.8 million. {Read more}

The exercise is conducted within the framework of the Five Power Defense Arrangements (FPDA) - a series of bilateral and multilateral defense agreements established in 1971. The drills have been organized annually since 2004. {Read more}
