

"Modi Story", a volunteer-driven initiative to uncover the life of Prime Minister Narendra Modi that will include anecdotes of his life as told by various personalities from different walks of life, was launched. The "Modi Story" web portal was inaugurated by the granddaughter of Mahatma Gandhi, Sumitra Gandhi Kulkarni. {Read more}

602. On March 25, National Company Law Tribunal (NCLT) declared Real estate developer Supertech Ltd as bankrupt. A two-member NCLT bench comprises P. S. N. Prasad and Rahul Bhatnagar. Acting on a petition filed by the Union Bank of India for non-payment of about ₹432 Cr worth dues, the bankruptcy court ordered the initiation of insolvency proceedings against real estate firm Supertech Ltd., one of the companies of Supertech group. The tribunal admits a petition and initiates CIRP on the corporate debtor with immediate effect. CIRP refers to Corporate Insolvency Resolution Process (CIRP). NCLT was created on the recommendations of Eradi Committee in 2016. {Read more}

603. On March 27, Union Minister Anurag Thakur launched a Skill India International Project namely "TEJAS" (Training for Emirates Jobs And Skills) at Dubai Expo to train overseas Indians. The project is aimed at skilling, certification and overseas employment of Indians. Tejas aims at creating a 10,000 strong Indian workforce in UAE during the initial phase. {Read more} Key Points:

604. On March 27, with the first pour of concrete for a 700 MW atomic power plant in Karnataka's Kaiga, India is set to start construction of 10 'fleet mode' nuclear reactors from 2023. The first pour of concrete (FPC) signals the beginning of construction of nuclear power reactors from the pre-project stage. The Centre had approved the construction of 10 indigenously developed pressurised heavy water reactors (PHWR) of 700 MW each in June 2017. The 10 PHWRs will be built at a cost of ₹1.05 lakh Cr. Currently, India operates 22 reactors with a total capacity of 6780 MW in operation. {Read more} **Key Points:**

Maharashtra State Co-operative Bank will give loans under the scheme up to ₹50,000 at an interest rate of 7%. The scheme will be implemented on a pilot basis at Yerawada Central Jail, Pune. Known as "Project Skyway", the blueprint for a 165 mile (265km) drone superhighway has been submitted by the consortium. 'Project Skyway' aims to enable businesses to develop and grow through commercialisation of innovative drone-based products, processes and service. {Read more} Key Points:

The system, which comprises 10 radar stations, was built with an Indian grant of \$15.8 million. Maldives President Ibrahim Solih and Jaishankar jointly inaugurated the National College of Policing and Law Enforcement in Addu city, one of the largest projects implemented in the Maldives with an Indian grant. {Read more}

The Sako rifles have replaced the .338 Lapua Magnum Scorpio TGT by Beretta, and the .50 Calibre M95 by Barrett, which were inducted in the Indian army in 2019 and 2020. These rifles were made in Italy and America. While the Sako TRG-42 sniper rifle is a bolt-action sniper rifle designed and developed by the Finnish gun maker SAKO. It has an effective range of 1,500 metres. {Read more}

NSM is a joint initiative of Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY) and Department of Science and Technology (DST). An MoU was signed between IIT Kharagpur and Centre for Development in Advanced Computing (CDAC) in March 2019 to establish this state-of the art Supercomputing Facility with 17680 CPU cores along with 44 GPUs. IIT Kharagpur has also established the Centre for Computational and Data Science with a mandate to train the researchers in Supercomputer accelerated R&D. {Read more}
