

256. On March 7, Odisha topped the list of full immunisation and became the only state in India to achieve 90.5% of immunization under 'Mission Indradhanush 4.0'. The intensified Mission Indradhanush (IMI) 4.0 was rolled out in the state for boosting full immunization coverage of the targeted women and children. Full immunisation includes preventive doses against 12 different kinds of diseases including polio, tuberculosis, jaundice, diphtheria, whooping cough, tetanus, HIV, brain fever, pneumonia, measles, rubella, diarrhea, Japanese fever, and others. {Read more}

A total of 4,261 LOIs for e-autos will be given with a 33% reservation for women. The portal has been created by Convergence Energy Services Limited (CESL). With the launch of the portal, Delhi government became the first state in the country to provide easy financing along with interest subvention on the purchase of EVs. {Read more}

AMRUT 2.0 is a transformative scheme with an outlay of over Rs 2.77 lakh Cr. Technology Sub-mission has been approved by Cabinet under 'AMRUT 2.0' to engage startups as 'Technology Partner'. Under this initiative, Ministry will select 100 start-ups which will be provided with Rs 20 lakhs as funding support as well as mentorship. {Read more}

On March 14, Agriculture and Farmers Welfare Ministry announced that more than 40,000 farmers across India benefited from the "Pusa Krishi Vigyan Mela" held from March 9 to 11, 2022. 41 Innovative awards were given to farmers during the festival. The mela was organised by Indian Agricultural Research Institute (IARI) on the theme "Self-reliant Farmer with Technical Knowledge" in New Delhi. {Read more}

On March 10, International Monetary Funds (IMF) approved \$1.4 billion in emergency financing for Ukraine amid the ongoing war with Russia under the Rapid Financing Instrument (RFI) to help meet urgent financing needs and mitigate the economic impact of the war. World Bank also approved a \$723 million package of loans and grants for Ukraine. World Bank has also set up a Multi-Donor Trust Fund (MDTF) to facilitate channeling grant resources from donors to Ukraine, with contributions from the UK, Denmark, Latvia, Lithuania, and Iceland in the amount of \$134 million thus far. Japan also linked \$100 million in parallel financing to the support package. {Read more}

263. On March 13, National Stock Exchange of India Ltd (NSE) and India Bullion and Jewelers Association Ltd (IBJA) partnered to launch the Domestic Bullion Spot Exchange in line with SEBI guidelines. India is the second-largest consumer of gold, and it is the first time that a domestic bullion spot exchange is being set up under the aegis of SEBI. {Read more}

On March 11, The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) directed Paytm Payments Bank to stop onboarding new customers with immediate effect by using its powers under Section 35A of the Banking Regulation Act, 1949. The bank was also directed to appoint an IT audit firm to conduct a comprehensive System Audit of its IT system. This action is based on certain material supervisory concerns observed in the bank. One97 Communications owns 49% equity interest in Paytm Payments Bank, while the rest 51% is owned by Vijay Shekhar Sharma. {Read more}

On March 11, Mumbai-based Prepaid Payment Instrument (PPI) Issuer LivQuik became the first PPI to achieve full Interoperability as mandated by the RBI thereby allowing its customers the choice of issuing a prepaid payment Instrument that can be leveraged by a card, wallet or UPI. The RBI laid down guidelines for allowing Interoperability of PPI instruments to provide choice to customers. PPI Issuers are mandated to facilitate interoperability for full-KYC wallets by 31st March 2022. Founded in 2012, LivQuik is an RBI authorised Prepaid Payment Instrument Issuer and operates 3 key business - Enterprise, Issuance & Acquiring. {Read more}

As per Refinitiv data, Axis Bank also ranks first in India in Debt Capital Markets (DCM) with 17.1% market share. This year, the bank won the "Best DCM House in India" Award at the IFR Asia Awards 2021. Axis Bank has been No. 1 on the Bloomberg League Table ranking for 15 consecutive calendar years. Globally, Morgan Stanley was honoured with the "Bank of the Year" Award and the JSW Group was awarded with the "Issuer of the Year" Award at the IFR Asia Award 2021. On March 14, Baroda Asset Management Company and BNP Paribas Asset Management Company entered into a strategic partnership by combining their respective asset management businesses to form a new joint venture (JV) AMC "Baroda BNP Paribas Mutual Fund". Suresh Soni has been appointed as the CEO of the merged entity. Bank of Baroda, the parent company of Baroda AMC, will hold 50.1% stake in the new JV AMC, while BNP Paribas AM will hold the remaining 49.9%. {Read more}

269. On March 15, the RBI released the final guidelines for Microfinance Loans and increased eligibility criteria for microfinance loans to a household having an annual income of up to Rs 3 lakh while removing the interest rate cap on such loans. Collateral-free loan given to a household having annual household income up to Rs 3 lakh will now be considered as 'Microfinance Loan', effective from April 1, 2022. Currently, a microfinance borrower is identified by the annual household income not exceeding Rs 1.25 lakh for rural and Rs 2 lakh for urban and semi-urban areas. The RBI also revised the criteria for NBFCs who do not qualify as NBFC-MFIs to extend microfinance loans up to 25% of their total assets from 10% earlier. {Read more}

270. On March 10, Tiger Woods was formally inducted into the World Golf Hall of Fame. Additionally, the World Golf Hall of Fame presented two new distinguished service awards for the first time. Renee Powell was honored as the inaugural recipient of the Charlie Sifford Award while Peter Ueberroth and the late Dick Ferris were honored through a Lifetime Achievement recognition for their contributions to golf. {Read more}

271. On March 7, Swedish Olympic champion, Armand Duplantis nicknamed "Mondo" broke his own world record in the Pole Vault, clearing 6.19m at his third attempt at the indoor meeting in Belgrade. He had held the record since February 2020, when he cleared 6.17m in Torun in Poland and then 6.18m in Glasgow. {Read more}

272. On March 12, Mithali Raj broke the record for most matches captained in the ICC Women's World Cup, surpassing former Australian counterpart Belinda Clark. She achieved the feat when she stepped out to lead the country against the West Indies. She led India in 24 World Cup games while Clark had captained her side in 23 matches. Mithali and Clark are the only two cricketers to have led their country at more than two World Cups. Moreover, recently Mithali became only the third cricketer and the first woman to appear in six World Cups, joining the iconic Sachin Tendulkar and Pakistani Javed Miandad. {Read more}

273. In March 2022, 325-mn-year-old fossil, unearthed in Montana, was named after Joe Biden. "Syllipsimopodi bideni" represents the oldest-known relative of today's Octopus. Some 325-328 million years later, a new paper published in Nature Communications provides some interesting insights into this mysterious and ancient cephalopod. Octopuses and squids are among the most familiar cephalopods, but also in this group are cuttlefishes, nautilus and the extinct belemnites, ammonites and others. {Read more}

274. On March 14, the Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) announced the successful ground testing of the newly developed Solid Booster Stage (SS1) for the new launch vehicle Small Satellite Launch Vehicle (SSLV). The SS1 stage was tested at Satish Dhawan Space Centre, Sriharikota. The remaining stages of SSLV (SS2 & SS3) have successfully undergone necessary ground tests and are ready for integration. SSLV is a small-lift launch vehicle with the capacity to deliver 600 kg payload to low Earth orbit (LEO) or 300 kg payload to Sun-synchronous orbit (SSO). The design of the vehicle was completed in 2018 by Vikram Sarabhai Space Centre (VSSC) and the maiden flight is expected in April 2022. {Read more}

The other two whole time members on the board of SEBI are SK Mohanty and Ananta Barua. The government has also nominated Ajay Seth and Rajesh Verma to the SEBI's board. [Read more]

According to the latest Sample Registration System (SRS) special bulletin on maternal mortality in India (2017-19), brought out by the office of the Registrar General of India, Kerala's MMR has dropped by 12 points.
