

National & States Affairs

401. On March 17, Delhi high court concluded that members of the armed forces (including Air Force, Navy & Army) can approach the High Courts to challenge the final decisions of the Armed Forces Tribunals (AFT) involving issues of pay, pension, promotion and discipline. On the other hand, the central government argued that members of the armed forces need not approach the High Courts against decisions of the AFTs as they have an alternative effective remedy of filing an appeal before the Supreme Court under Armed Forces Tribunal Act. {Read more}

402. On March 16, the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) placed the US-based Hewlett Foundation on its watchlist following an investigation that foreign contributions sent by it were being used for climate awareness campaigns, an activity not permissible under the FCRA (Foreign Contribution (Regulation) Act). Hewlett Foundation was placed under the "Prior Reference Category (PRC)" under the provisions of the FCRA after it emerged that it also sent funds via the European Climate Foundation (ECF). The ECF is also a foreign donor. When a foreign donor is included in the PRC, banks are mandated to seek the MHA's clearance before any grant or donation is transferred to the intended NGO. {Read more}

403. On March 16, National Capital Regional Transport Corporation (NCRTC) unveiled India's first Rapid Rail. The Regional Rapid Transit System (RRTS) train will run on the Delhi-Ghaziabad-Meerut corridor and cover a distance of 82 km in just 55 minutes. It will also be the first in the country to have a business or 'premium' coach on a regional corridor. {Read more} **Key Points:**

404. On March 18, PM Narendra Modi inaugurated the year-long celebrations of the centenary year (100th anniversary) of Malayalam newspaper namely "Mathrubhumi". Mathrubhumi began operations on March 18, 1923. The newspaper has 15 editions and 11 periodicals. {Read more}

The project will be India's first green hydrogen-based energy storage project. The hydrogen would be produced using the advanced 240kW solid oxide electrolyser by taking input power from the nearby floating solar project. {Read more}

409. On March 14, the ceremony for a new facility of Helicopter Engines MRO Pvt Limited (HE-MRO) was held at Sattari in Goa. HE-MRO is a joint venture of Hindustan Aeronautics Ltd (HAL) and Safran. The facility will be operational by the end of 2023 with a capacity to repair 50 engines a year and a full-capacity goal of 150 engines in the coming years. Both companies signed an MoU to extend their cooperation for new helicopter engines in civil and military markets towards India's vision of "Atmanirbhar Bharat". HAL has produced over 500 Shakti engines till date. Shakti is the Indian variant of the Safran Ardiden 1H1, co-developed with HAL. {Read more}

410. On March 18, Turkey's President Tayyip Erdogan inaugurated the World's Longest Suspension Bridge across Turkey's Dardanelles Strait. Connecting Turkey's European and Asian shores, the '1915 Canakkale Bridge' was built by Turkish and South Korean firms with an investment of 2.5 billion euros (\$2.8 billion). The 2,023 metre (1.25 mile) length of its midspan is an allusion to the Turkish Republic's 100th anniversary in 2023. It is the fourth bridge linking the European and Asian shores in Turkey, alongside the three built in Istanbul. Its towers are 318 metres (347.8 yards) high and the total length of the bridge is 4.6 km (2.9 miles). {Read more}

411. On March 18, the UN Security Council (UNSC) adopted a resolution to extend the mandate of the UN Assistance Mission in Afghanistan (UNAMA) for a year till March 17, 2023. Resolution 2626 decides that UNAMA and the UN Secretary-General's special representative will continue to carry out their mandate in support of the people of Afghanistan. The resolution was adopted with 14 votes in favour. Russia abstained. {Read more}

414. On March 21, Digital payments platform PhonePe acquired 100% stake in Pune-based GigIndia, a network for freelance micro-entrepreneurs. GigIndia has 1.5 million entrepreneurs and over 100 enterprises as customers. According to some estimates, India's freelance community space is projected to grow to \$20-30 billion by 2025. {Read more}

On liquidation, every depositor with the bank would be entitled to receive deposit insurance claim amount of his/her deposits up to a monetary ceiling of Rs 5 lakh from the Deposit Insurance and Credit Guarantee Corporation (DICGC), subject to the provisions of the DICGC Act, 1961. {Read more}

The 3D Printed houses were inaugurated in presence of Engineer in Chief Lt Gen Harpal Singh. {Read more}

This new facility will support the research and development (R&D) activities to develop the avionics for fighter aircraft and FCS for the fifth generation Advanced Medium Combat Aircraft (AMCA). The complex is constructed by DRDO in a record 45 days, with in-house hybrid technology consisting of conventional, pre-engineered and precast methodology. The technology is developed by DRDO and Larsen & Toubro (L&T). Design check and technical support is provided by the teams of IIT Madras and IIT Roorkee. {Read more}

421. On March 20, Venezuelan athlete, Yulimar Rojas won a Gold medal in triple jump at the "World Indoor Championships 2022" in Belgrade, Serbia. With this, she created a World Record by clearing 15.74 metres on her sixth and final effort in Belgrade, smashing the previous world indoor best of 15.43m she set in Madrid in February 2020. She also holds the outdoor world record, 15.67m, which she set when winning gold in Tokyo last summer. Moreover, Ukraine's Yaroslava Mahuchikh won a Gold medal in the women's high jump at the World Indoor Championships 2022. The Ukrainian went out to 14.74m with her sixth and final effort. {Read more}

422. On March 21, American Taylor Fritz claimed the biggest pay-cheque of his tennis career, winning his maiden ATP Masters 1000 title by defeating Spanish stalwart Rafael Nadal in the BNP Paribas Open. Fritz became the first American men's champion at Indian Wells since Andre Agassi in 2001. It was 21-time Grand Slam-winner Nadal's first defeat of the 2022 season. The Indian Wells Masters, also known as the Indian Wells Open and BNP Paribas Open is an annual tennis tournament. {Read more}

Although the all-time top goalscorer title in football is much contested and FIFA does not keep an official record, but the world governing body estimates that, earlier, Austro-Czech Josef Bican had scored 805 goals during a career that lasted from 1931 to 1955. {Read more}

426. India was represented by an 11-member shotgun contingent in the event. Italy finished at the top of the standings with three of the 10 gold medals on offer, while Turkey came second and Slovakia third. {Read more}
