1. On May 1, The government has set a target to raise Foodgrain Production by 2% and to buy 42.74 MT for the central pool during 2021-22. The target of total food grains production for 2021-22 is set at a record 307.31 million tonne (MT), comprising 151.43 MT in Kharif season and 155.88 MT during Rabi. For 2021-22, the target for rice production has been fixed at 121.1 MT, wheat at 110 MT, pulses at 25MT, coarse cereals at 51.21 MT and oilseeds at 37.5MT. As per Economic Survey 2020-21, Agriculture's share in GDP has increased to 19.9% in 2020-21 compared to 17.8% in 2019-20. {Read more}

2. On May 1, French company Alstom has successfully manufactured and delivered the 100th electric locomotive to the Indian Railways. As part of the largest FDI project of the railways, the Ministry of Railways and Alstom had signed a contract worth 350 Cr euros (Rs 25,000 Cr) in 2015. The locomotives were manufactured at Madhepura, Bihar. {Read more}
