**301.** On May 12, The Union Cabinet has approved the proposal of the Department of Heavy Industry for implementation of the Production Linked Incentive (PLI) Scheme. "National Programme on Advanced Chemistry Cell (ACC) Battery Storage" was included with an outlay of ₹18,100 Cr. Each selected ACC battery Storage manufacturer would have to commit to set-up an ACC manufacturing facility of minimum 5 GWh capacity and ensure a minimum 60% domestic value addition at the Project level within 5 years. {Read more} **Key Points:**
