As per the Bill, a forcible conversion by marriage, or by getting a person married, or by aiding a person to get married shall invite imprisonment of 3 to 5 years and a fine of up to ₹2 lakh. If the victim is a minor, woman, Dalit or tribal, the offender may be punished with a jail term of 4 to 7 years and a fine of not less than ₹3 lakh. {Read more}
