Moreover, CSIR-AROMA Mission, under the Ministry of Science & Technology, aims to develop and disseminate aroma-related science and technology to reach the end-users/clients of CSIR: Farmers, industry and society. {Read more}

705. On May 30, PARAM ANANTA, a state-of the art Supercomputer at IIT Gandhinagar, dedicated to the nation under National Supercomputing Mission (NSM), was commissioned. The NSM is a joint initiative of Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology (MeitY) and Department of Science & Technology (DST). An MoU was signed between IIT Gandhinagar and Centre for Development in Advanced Computing (C-DAC) on 12th October, 2020 to establish this 838 TeraFlops Supercomputing Facility under NSM. PARAM ANANTA system is based on Direct Contact Liquid Cooling technology to obtain a high power usage effectiveness and thereby reducing the operational cost. Under NSM, till date 15 supercomputers, manufactured in India, have been installed across the nation with aggregate compute capacity of 24 petaflops. {Read more}

706. On May 30, the National Health Authority (NHA), under its flagship scheme of Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM), has launched a Public Dashboard for real-time information. The public dashboard will be a one-stop solution for information on the mission's progress at state level. The dashboard, under the mission, will display detailed information on core registries like - Ayushman Bharat Health Account (ABHA) numbers, Healthcare Professionals Registry (HPR) and Health Facility Registry (HFR). Till date, a total of 22.1 Cr ABHAs (earlier known as health ID) have been created. The ABDM public dashboard gives a transparent view of the number of ABHA generated on national as well as state/UT level. {Read more}

The Nechiphu Tunnel, at an altitude of 5,700 feet, is a unique 500-metre-long, D-shaped, single tube double lane tunnel. The "ASTRA MK-I" air-to-air missile was designed and developed by the DRDO. The missile is fully integrated onto the 'Su-30 MK-I' fighter aircraft. The Indian Navy will integrate the missile on the 'MiG 29K' fighter aircraft. {Read more}

The second qualifier was played by Rajasthan Royals and Royal Challengers Bangalore. IPL final was held on the 30th of May between Gujarat Titans and Rajasthan Royals in the Narendra Modi stadium, Ahmedabad, and was won by a one-sided match by Gujarat Titans. 2007-08 was the launching year of the IPL. The first-ever IPL was won by Rajasthan Royals in 2008. Gujarat Titans is the first sports team in India to launch its team logo named "The Titans Dugout" in metaverse. Ashish Nehra was the head coach of Gujarat Titans, while Hardik Pandya was the captain of the team. {Read more}

Manish Kaurav (KL3 Men 200m) and Manjeet Singh (VL2 Men 200m) also reached the finals for the first time ever in the history of the tournament. {Read more}

727. On May 30, the official 59th edition of the "List of the World's Top 500 Supercomputers" was unveiled in Germany. Frontier, developed by US's designated supercomputer facility, the Oak Ridge Leadership Computing Facility, is the world's first supercomputer to cross the performance margin of 1 exaflops. With this, the supercomputer has surpassed Fugaku, belonging to Japan's Riken Centre for Computational Science, as the world's most powerful supercomputer right now. Fugaku has a performance score of 442 petaflops. 1 exaflop is equivalent to 1,000 petaflops. Frontier is built using Hewlett Packard Enterprise (HPE) architecture and powered by Advanced Micro Devices (AMD) processors. Moreover, Param Siddhi is India's High Performance Computing-Artificial Intelligence (HPC-AI) supercomputer developed by Dept. of S & T, MeitY, under National Supercomputing Mission (NSM) at Centre for Development of Advanced Computing (C-DAC). Param Siddhi offers peak performance of 3.3 petaflops. {Read more}
