The authenticity and purity of the hallmarked gold jewellery items with the Hallmark Unique Identification (HUID) number, purchased by the consumer, can also be verified by using 'verify HUID' in the 'BIS CARE' app. {Read more}

However, some states in the US have already banned menthol cigarettes, but the FDA plans to extend the prohibition countrywide. The proposed ban does not cover electronic cigarettes. Tobacco regulation laws in India are covered under "Cigarettes and Other Tobacco Products (Prohibition of Advertisement and Regulation of Trade and Commerce, Production, Supply and Distribution) Act, 2003" or "COTPA, 2003". {Read more}

Science & Technology

24. The National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) announced to shut down the operations of Stratospheric Observatory for Infrared Astronomy (SOFIA) mission, the world's largest flying telescope by September 30, 2022. SOFIA had confirmed the presence of water on the Moon and it's been in operation since 2014. SOFIA is a collaboration between NASA and the German Space Agency (DLR). NASA's decision to shut down SOFIA closely follows the White House's 2023 federal budget request released on 28 March 2022, which did not allocate money to SOFIA. SOFIA is operating at the cost of about \$85 million per year. {Read more}
