This is part of the Indus basin. Under the '1960 vintage Indus Water Treaty (IWT)' between India and Pakistan, the two countries share the waters of 6 rivers in the Indus basin that flow through India towards Pakistan. The Kwar hydropower project will be implemented by Chenab Valley Power Projects Private Ltd (CVPPL), a JV between NHPC Ltd and J&K State Power Development Corporation (JKSPDC). The Kwar Hydro Electric Project shall be commissioned within a span of 54 months. {Read more}

62. India is not among the 60 countries that have signed a global declaration to keep the Internet open, free, and neutral. The countries that have signed the declaration include the US, European Union, United Kingdom, Canada, France, etc. Called the "Declaration for the Future of the Internet", the document is an agreement to prevent digital authoritarianism. India, China and Russia are among the large nations that are not part of this declaration. A total of 182 internet crackdowns were reported globally in 2021. Out of 106 shutdowns in India, 85 were reported in Jammu and Kashmir. The number of countries that shut down the internet in 2021 has increased to 34 from 29 in 2020. {Read more}

With this, India got its 100th unicorn. This funding signifies the enthusiasm in the Indian startup ecosystem, which is the world's third-largest according to Economic Survey, 2021-22. India overtook the UK to reach the spot after the US and China, which added 487 and 301 unicorns respectively, according to the survey. {Read more}

The RBI's Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) held an off-cycle meeting on 2 & 4 May, 2022 to reassess the evolving inflation-growth dynamics and the impact of the developments after the MPC meeting of April 6-8, 2022. Based on this assessment of the macroeconomic situation and the outlook, the MPC voted unanimously to increase the policy reporate by 40 basis points to 4.40 %, with immediate effect. Consequently, the standing deposit facility (SDF) rate stands adjusted to 4.15%; and the marginal standing facility (MSF) rate and the Bank Rate to 4.65%. Cash Reserve Ratio (CRR) is hiked by 50 bps to 4.50% from 4%. While the Statutory Liquidity Ratio (SLR) and Reverse Repo Rate (RRR) stand at the same which is 18% & 3.35% respectively. {Read more}

On May 3, Non-Banking financial company IIFL Finance Ltd and Open Financial Technologies, Asia's largest SME focused neo-banking platform, announced a joint venture (JV) to launch India's first neobank that would cater to banking and credit requirements of Micro and Small Enterprises (MSMEs). Initial capital of the joint venture company will be Rs 120 Cr. The JV composition between IIFL Finance and Open is 51:49. The name of the joint venture would be IIFL Open Fintech Private Limited. Recently, Open became the 100th unicorn as IIFL led a \$50 million series D funding along with existing investors Temasek, Tiger Global and 3one4 Capital. {Read more}
