151. On May 7, Reliance Industries Ltd (RIL) has reported a 20.2% rise in net profit at Rs 18,201 Cr for the quarter ended March 2022 as against Rs 14,995 Cr in the same period of last year. With this, RIL's gross revenue for the fiscal 2021-22 has crossed \$100 billion mark (Rs 7,92,756 Cr), the first Indian listed company to achieve the landmark. RIL's revenue in FY22 has increased 47%. Net profit for the full year was Rs 67,845 Cr (\$9 billion), higher by 26.2%. {Read more}

A team led by scientists from Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) in the US discovered a rare "Triple Black Widow" system - a pair of stars that rapidly circle each other before one is consumed by the other. It is located some 3,000 light-years away. The star system named "ZTF J1406+1222" has the shortest known orbit of any black widow binary i.e. 62 minutes. The system derives its name from the "black widow" spiders. The study used HiPERCAM, a high-speed camera developed by researchers at the University of Sheffield. {Read more}

181. 7th anniversaries of three social security (Jan Suraksha) schemes, Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana (PMJJBY), Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana (PMSBY) and Atal Pension Yojana (APY) were observed on May 9, 2022. PMJJBY, PMSBY and APY were launched by PM Narendra Modi on May 9, 2015 from Kolkata, West Bengal. The PMJJBY and PMSBY provide access to low cost life/accidental insurance cover to the people, while the APY provides an opportunity for saving in the present for getting a regular pension in old age. Age criteria is 18-50 years for PMJJBY, 18-70 years for PMSBY & 18-40 years for APY. While the benefit under PMJJBY is a life cover of Rs 2 Lakh, accidental death cum disability cover of Rs 2 lakh under PMSBY & the guaranteed minimum monthly pension of Rs 1000 or Rs 2000 or Rs 3000 or Rs 4000 or Rs 5000 at the age of 60 years under APY. {Read more}

Important Days & Dates

182. The 161st birth anniversary of Rabindranath Tagore was observed on May 7, 2022. Rabindranath Tagore, India's first Nobel Prize winner, was born in Kolkata on May 7, 1861. He was a poet, writer, playwright, composer, philosopher, social reformer and painter. Tagore was known as the Bard of Bengal and Gurudev. In 1913, Tagore became the first non-European to win a Nobel Prize in Literature. The Bengali poet was awarded a 'Knighthood' by King George V in 1915, however, he repudiated it after the 1919 Jallianwala Bagh massacre. {Read more}

183. The 77th anniversary of the end of WW2 was marked in 2022. VE Day (Victory in Europe) is celebrated every 8 May and May 8, 1945 is the day on which Allied forces formally announced the surrender of Germany, which brought the Second World War to an End in Europe. {Read more}

193. On May 6, the National Statistical Office (NSO) released the 13th Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS). Unemployment Rate (UR) in urban areas for persons of age 15 years and above decreased to 8.7% in October-December (Q3) 2021 from 10.3% in Q3 2020. During Q3 2021, the UR among females was 10.5% and among males, the UR was 8.3%. Moreover, the Worker Population Ratio (WPR) in CWS (Current Weekly Status) was 43.2% in Q3 2021. While the Labour Force Participation Rate (LFPR) in CWS was 47.3% in Q3-2021. {Read more}

194. As on May 2022, Rajasthan became the first state in India to surpass 10 GW of cumulative large-scale solar installations, as per Mercom's "India Solar Project Tracker". The state has a total of 32.5 GW of installed power capacity, with renewables contributing 55%, followed by thermal energy at 43%, and nuclear energy making up for the remaining 2%. According to Mercom's India Solar Project Tracker, Rajasthan has over 16 GW of solar projects under development. Moreover, THDC India recently signed a Letter of Intent (LoI) to build 10 GW solar power projects through a 74:36 joint venture with Rajasthan Renewable Energy Corporation Limited, entailing an investment of Rs 100 billion. {Read more}

The "2022 Global Gas Flaring Tracker", a leading global and independent indicator of gas flaring, produced by the World Bank's Global Gas Flaring Reduction Partnership (GGFR) finds that the top 10 flaring countries accounted for 75% of all gas flared. The report finds that reductions in both absolute flare volumes and flaring intensity have stalled in the last decade. In 2021, 144 billion cubic meters of gas was needlessly burnt in flares at upstream oil and gas facilities across the globe. {Read more}

More than 50,000 children have been rescued by the RPF under "Operation Nanhe Frishte" from across India since 2018 working with different stakeholders. RPF has recently also launched a nationwide drive against trafficking, called "Operation AAHT (Action against Human Trafficking)" to take stringent action against human trafficking through rail. Besides all this, the RPF has also set up Anti Human Trafficking Units (AHTUs) at more than 740 locations across India. The Indian Railway is the primary transporter for the nation and therefore is a major route for human traffickers. {Read more}
