251. On May 6, Central Zoo Authority of India has given nod to India's first safari dedicated to gaurs to come up in Shivamogga district of Karnataka. The gaur also known as the Indian bison, has been listed as Vulnerable on the IUCN Red List since 1986. {Read more}

The U.K. Health Security Agency (UKHSA) informed that monkeypox is a rare viral infection that does not spread easily between people and is usually a mild "self-limiting illness" and most people recover within a few weeks. It can be spread when someone is in close contact with an infected person. The virus can enter the body through broken skin, the respiratory tract or through the eyes, nose or mouth. The first-ever recorded occurrence of the monkeypox virus in the U.K. was in 2018. {Read more}

India's flagship digital payments platform - Unified Payments Interface (UPI) saw its highest ever number of transactions in April 2022 at 5.58 billon, amounting to Rs 9.83 trillion, up 33% compared to previous month. In March, UPI processed 5.4 billion transactions amounting to Rs 9.6 trillion for the first time. However, year-on-year (YoY), the volume of transactions jumped 111% and value of transactions increased by almost 100%. In FY22, UPI processed more than 46 billion transactions, amounting to over Rs 84.17 trillion. {Read more} Key Points:

264. Life Insurance Corporation's IPO, the country's biggest public offer, was subscribed 2.95 times on the last day of offer period on May 9, helping the government mobilise about Rs 21,000 Cr. Against 16,20,78,067 shares on offer, 47,83,25,760 bids were received. LIC had fixed the price band at Rs 902-949 per equity share for the issue. The retail investors and eligible employees received a discount of Rs 45 per equity share, while policyholders received a discount of Rs 60 per share. With this, the government diluted 3.5% stake in the insurance behemoth through the Offer for Sale (OFS). {Read more}

277. On May 10, "Pulitzer Prize 2022" winners in Journalism, Books, Drama and Music were announced. The winner's list included four Indians - Adnan Abidi, Sanna Irshad Mattoo, Amit Dave, and the late Danish Siddiqui of Reuters, who were awarded "2022 Pulitzer Prizes" in Journalism. Danish Siddiqui posthumously won the 'Pulitzer Prize 2022' for images of COVID's toll in India. Journalists from Ukraine were recognised with a '2022 Pulitzer Prize Special Citation'. While the list for Books, Drama and Music included, "The Netanyahus" novel by Joshua Cohen for Fiction, "Fat Ham" by James Ijames for Drama, "Covered with Night" book Nicole Eustace & "Cuba: An American History" by Ada Ferrer for History, "Frank: sonnets" by Diane Seuss for Poetry, "Voiceless Mass" by Raven Chacon for Music. {Read more}

The president of the Royal Institute of British Architects (RIBA) Simon Allford presented the medal to the renowned architect in person at his residence in Ahmedabad. The Ahmedabad-based distinguished architect is among the rare people to have been awarded both the Royal Gold Medal and the Pritzker Architecture Prize in their lifetime. In India, he was awarded the Padma Bhushan in 2020. He is also the recipient of the French 'Global Award for Lifetime Achievement for Sustainable Architecture' by the Institut Francais d'architecture, Paris. {Read more}

On May 11, the Haryana government launched the "Chaara-Bijaee Yojana" to encourage farmers to grow fodder and help gaushalas, which have been grappling with fodder shortage amid a rise in the stray cattle population. Under the scheme, farmers who have tied up with gaushalas, will be eligible to receive a financial aid of ₹10,000 per acre for up to 10 acres under fodder cultivation. The number of cow shelters in the state increased from 175 in 2017 to 600 in 2022. {Read more}
