Part of China's Earth Summit Mission 2022, the airship is studying the environment above the highest peak in the world. The annual rate of inflation was 15.08% (Provisional) for the month of April, 2022 (Y-o-Y) as compared to 10.74% in April, 2021. The rate of inflation based on WPI Food Index increased marginally from 8.71% in March, 2022 to 8.88% in April, 2022. 420. On May 18, Herpetologists in Mizoram have recorded a new species of non-venomous snake living away from sources of water unlike its six recognised sister-species. The new-to-science snake named "lenrul", meaning high-elevation snake in the Mizo language, is the only one of its kind in India found beyond 1,700 metres above the mean sea level. The snake's scientific name is Herpetoreas murlen, derived from the place it was found - Murlen National Park in Champhai district of Mizoram. {Read more}

On May 19, Chinese scientists have proposed a space project to survey the sky through a space-borne telescope to hunt for habitable Earth-like planets outside the solar system, about 32 light-years from Earth. The project, named Closeby Habitable Exoplanet Survey (CHES), if carried out, will be the first space mission specially designed to search for habitable terrestrial planets around nearby Sun-like stars. The CHES will observe about 100 Sun-like stars 32 light-years away on a long-term survey and will hopefully discover roughly 50 Earth-like planets or super-Earths, planets that are up to about 10 times the mass of Earth. {Read more}

On May 18, a team of scientists at the Kerala University of Fisheries and Ocean Studies (Kufos) has standardised the techniques for artificial breeding of Olive barbs (Kuruva Paral) and Filament barb (Kalakkodiyan), and have developed brood stocks for Highfin barb (Kooral) and Carnatic carp (Pachilavetti). The conservation measures being taken up by Kufos are supported under the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP)-India High Range Landscape project. The university has also set up a Hatchery at Idamalayar with the support of the UNDP. {Read more}

423. A team of Australian researchers have identified a biochemical marker in the blood that could help identify newborn babies at risk for sudden infant death syndrome (SIDS). In their study, babies who died of SIDS had lower levels of an enzyme called butyrylcholinesterase (BChE) shortly after birth. BChE plays a major role in the brain's arousal pathway, and low levels would reduce a sleeping infant's ability to wake up or respond to its environment. {Read more}

424. The Denisovans, an extinct group of archaic humans first discovered in a Siberian cave in 2008, were found outside of northern Asia too, the analysis of a tooth found in a Laos cave has shown. The tooth, a permanent lower molar, was discovered by a team of scientists in December 2018 from Cobra Cave in Hua Pan province, Laos. The scientists published their study titled "A Middle Pleistocene Denisovan molar from the Annamite Chain of northern Laos" in the journal 'Nature Communications' on May 17, 2022. {Read more}

This report is the culmination of the 71st World Health Assembly resolution in 2018 to prepare a global report on effective access to assistive technology. An analysis of 35 countries revealed that Access to Assistive Technology varies from 3% in poorer nations to 90% in wealthy countries. The report notes that the number of people in need of one or more assistive products is likely to rise to 3.5 billion by 2050, due to populations ageing and the prevalence of noncommunicable diseases rising across the world. {Read more}

The report compiled information on inequities across sectors of health, education, household characteristics and the labour market. The country's unemployment rate was 4.8% in 2019-20, and the worker population ratio was 46.8%. The share of the top 1% accounts for 6-7% of the total incomes earned, while the top 10% accounts for one-third of all incomes earned. In the area of health infrastructure, total health centers in India in 2020 stood at 1,85,505, from 1,72,608 health centers in 2005. {Read more}

Men will contribute to 14.7 million Years of Life Lost (YLLs), 0.72 million Years Lived with Disability (YLDs) and 15.5 million Disability Adjusted Life Years (DALYs) in 2025. The highest incidence last year was in the North (2,408 patients per 1,00,000) and the Northeast (2,177 per 1,00,000). According to a report by the Indian Council for Medical Research on the 'Burden of cancers in India', seven types of Cancer accounted for more than 40% of the total disease burden, with the highest cases of lung cancer (10.6%). Mizoram, Delhi and Meghalaya had the highest cancer DALYs and the most vulnerable demographic are people in the 65-69-year age group.
