The first phase of the project will be undertaken at a cost of around ₹10,500 Cr, and the work on it is scheduled to be completed by 2024. It will be India's first Net Zero Carbon Emissions airport. With this, Uttar Pradesh will become the only state in India to have 5 International airports. {Read more}

The new series of WRI with base 2016=100 will replace the old series with base 1963-65. 566. On November 25, the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) issued fresh operating norms for the introduction of Silver Exchange Traded Funds (ETFs) in India. This comes after the SEBI recently amended MFs regulations to have mechanism for silver ETFs. In its latest circular, the SEBI mandated that a silver ETF scheme by mutual funds have to invest at least 95% of the net assets in silver and silver related instruments. This regulation is similar to gold ETFs. {Read more}

Based on the recommendation, the RBI raised limit on promoters' stake from the current levels of 15% to 26% of the paid-up voting equity share capital of the bank. Bank promoters currently do not include industrial groups whose holdings in a bank are capped at 10%. {Read more}

The aircrafts would now be upgraded to the latest standards as part of the 'Mirage 2000H Upgrade Programme' deal with Hindustan Aeronautics Ltd (HAL). {Read more}
