The special collectors' coin was designed by Heena Glover and features an image of a lotus, India's national flower, alongside one of Gandhi's most famous quotes 'My life is my Message'. It is the first time that Gandhi has been commemorated on an official UK coin with the final design chosen by UK Chancellor Rishi Sunak, who is the Master of the Mint. {Read more}

This will form an addendum to the Protocol of the 2016 India-Bhutan Agreement on Trade, Commerce and Transit.



Since 2014, trade between India and Bhutan has more than doubled from USD 484 million in 2014-15 to USD 1083 million in 2020-21. {Read more}

As an agency bank of the RBI, Bandhan bank will handle transactions related to collection of state taxes and revenue receipts such as the GST and VAT; collection of stamp duty and pension payments on behalf of the central and state governments. {Read more}

The state government gives a monthly unemployment allowance of ₹4,000 to men and ₹4,500 to women, transgender and differently abled people. For a person to avail the unemployment allowance, he or she should be a graduate and have an annual family income of less than ₹2 lakh. {Read more}

70. On November 3, Delhi's Social welfare minister Rajendra Pal Gautam announced reopening of applications under "Jai Bhim Mukhyamantri Pratibha Vikas Yojana". Under this scheme, meritorious students belonging to SC/ST/OBC and EWS categories receive free coaching from private institutes for competitive exams such as JEE, NEET, CLAT, civil services, banking, railways, SSC among others. The scheme was put on hold in 2020 due to Covid. AAP government will provide them free coaching and also provide a stipend of Rs 2,500 to the beneficiary students for traveling. {Read more}
