151. On November 8, 49 cities were recently added to the UNESCO Creative Cities Network (UCCN) and India's Srinagar was also among them. The network now numbers 295 cities reaching 90 countries. After Mumbai, Chennai, Hyderabad, Varanasi and Jaipur; Srinagar is the 6th Indian City to become a part of UCCN and it is selected under the 'craft and folk arts' category. {Read more}
