101. On November 3, The Apparel Export Promotion Council (AEPC) launched Apparel Industry Sustainability Action (AISA) 2022–2023, aimed at evaluating the existing status of the Indian garment industry, encouraging wider penetration of sustainability measures amongst MSMEs, hand-holding them with demonstrations and solutions, and enhancing the brand visibility of sustainable companies on a global platform. AEPC also released a sustainability compendium during the conclave and the companies included in it will be showcased on the dedicated sustainability social media platform for wide publicity that will finally culminate in sustainability awards. {Read more}

102. On November 5, Kerala became the first state in India to launch uniform gold price based on the bank rate. The decision to introduce uniform price on 916 purity 22 carat gold has been taken at a meeting between officials of Malabar Gold and Diamonds, one of the largest gold and diamond retail chains in India and key members of All Kerala Gold and Silver Merchants Association which sets the board rate for gold. Uniform gold price based on bank rate offers an opportunity to the consumers to purchase gold at a reasonable and transparent price. {Read more} **Key Points:**

103. On November 4, the government has constituted an expert panel to prepare a 'National Drugs Database' which will list the information on the drug, its manufacturer or marketer, dosage forms and strengths. The seven-member panel will be led by AK Pradhan. At present, there is no comprehensive national database which provides all details on drugs. The Ministry of Health maintains 'Sugam', an index of drug licenses issued to companies by state FDAs, while drug prices regulator NPPA separately collects data on companies for price control. This seems to be corrective action being taken by the government to address the issue of quality monitoring and regulatory policing, after the deaths of 66 kids in Gambia last month after the consumption of cough syrups made from "sub-standard toxic ingredients" by a domestic firm, Maiden Pharma. **(Read more) Key Points:**

On November 3, Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman released the 6th tranche of commercial coal mines auction, under which the government is offering 141 blocks across 11 States, the biggest coal mine auction so far. 105. On November 4, Aibawk cluster in the Aizwal district of Mizoram became the first cluster to be completed under the Shyama Prasad Mukherji Rurban Mission (SPMRM). SPMRM was launched by the Prime Minister in February 2016 with a vision to provide amenities to rural areas which are perceived to be urban and have the potential to stimulate local economic development. Infrastructure created includes roads, footpaths, drains, water supply, and car parking and social infrastructures like a conference center, sports infrastructure. {Read more} **Key Points:**

This is the third month in a row when UIDAI has topped the rankings. UIDAI has been a top performer in resolution of cases received through Centralized Public Grievance Redress and Monitoring System (CPGRAMS). In order to further enhance residents' experience, UIDAI has also launched its new AI/ML based Chatbot, "Aadhaar Mitra". A resident centric coordinated approach enables UIDAI to resolve nearly 92% of CRM Grievances within a week. {Read more} **Key Points:**

111. On November 8, Adani New Industries Limited (ANIL) announced the installation of India's tallest Wind Turbine Generator (WTG) in Mundra, Gujarat. A 200 metres tall wind turbine, taller than the world's tallest Statue of Unity (182m), has been installed at Mundra in Gujarat by Adani New Industries Ltd as part of its renewable energy expansion plans. The turbine has been installed by Mundra Windtech Ltd (MWL), a wholly-owned subsidiary incorporated by Adani Enterprises Ltd (AEL). This prototype is also the first addition to the portfolio of ANIL. The wind turbine has the capacity to produce 5.2 MW of electricity and can power approximately 4,000 homes. This machine is a first and has been built with technology from W2E (Wind to Energy) of Germany. It will work at wind speeds as low as 3 metres per second (mps) and up to 20 mps, reaching its optimum power production at around 12 mps wind speeds. {Read more}

On November 3, the National Commission for Scheduled Tribes (NCST) has now cleared the way for the inclusion of the 'Pahari ethnic group' in the Scheduled Tribes list of the Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir. The proposal recommended by the commission also called for the inclusion of the "Paddari tribe", "Koli" and "Gadda Brahman" communities to be included in the ST list of J&K. For addition to the ST list of J&K, the Ministry of Tribal Affairs will be required to bring a Bill in Parliament to amend the "The Constitution (J&K) Scheduled Tribes Order, 1989". Following this, the addition will be finalised once the President of India notifies the revised schedule as empowered by 'Article 342' of the Constitution of India. {Read more}

On November 4, AstraZeneca and Sanofi's Beyfortus namely 'Nirsevimab' has been approved in the European Union (EU) for the prevention of respiratory syncytial virus (RSV) lower respiratory tract disease in newborns and infants during their first RSV season.1 Beyfortus is the first and only single-dose RSV passive immunisation for the broad infant population, including those born healthy, at term or preterm, or with specific health conditions. RSV is a common and highly contagious seasonal virus, infecting nearly all children by the age of two. The EU is the first regulatory body to grant approval to Beyfortus. {Read more}

On November 2, C2FO, a global on-demand working capital platform announced that its India arm C2FO Factoring Solutions Private Limited has got an in-principle approval from the Reserve Bank of India to set up and operate Trade Receivable Discounting Systems (TReDS) platform in India. With this, C2FO has become the fourth platform to get the license to operate TReDS after Receivables Exchange of India Ltd (RXIL), M1Xchange and Invoicemart. The fintech platform C2FO provides working capital to businesses and claims to be serving more than ten lakh businesses across 160 countries. Out of these, two lakh businesses are in India with a significant share of micro, small and medium enterprises (MSMEs). The minimum paid-up equity capital to set up and operate the TReDS is Rs 25 Cr. {Read more} **Key Points:**

In the men's doubles final, Pramod Bhagat and Manoj Sarkar won Silver medal as they lost to Indonesia's Hikmat Ramdani and Ukun Rukaendi. Another Indian Sukant Kadam won bronze in the men's SL4 category. India finished at 5th position with a total of 16 medals (2 Gold) at the "2022 BWF Para Badminton World Championships". Indonesia topped the championship with 11 medals (6 Gold). {Read more}

122. On November 2, Bellatrix Aerospace, a Bengaluru-based company announced to establish a research and development (R&D) centre and manufacturing factory for space taxis (orbital transfer vehicles or OTVs) and propulsion systems for rockets and satellites at the aerospace park near Kempegowda International Airport (KIA) by late 2023. The new facility is expected to be worth \$76 million (around Rs 630 Cr). At the new facility, aside from the space taxi, the firm will manufacture four of its thrusters: The Hall thruster, microwave plasma thruster, nano thrusters and green propulsion systems. Bellatrix last year tested India's first privately built Hall Thruster - a highly efficient electric propulsion system for satellites. It was also the first to develop the world's first commercial Microwave Plasma Thruster, which uses water as fuel. The firm has collaborations with other space companies - SatSure, Skyroot Aerospace and Dhruva Space on its ambitious orbital transfer vehicle (OTV) mission. {Read more}

123. On November 6, Google launched an A.I. platform that displays flood forecasts, namely "FloodHub". This platform shows the area and time where floods could occur, in order to inform people about the natural calamity and authorities can assist them with effectively. It has also expanded its AI flood forecasting services to 18 counties across Latin America, Africa and Southeast Asia. To recall, these flood forecasting services supported by AI were first introduced in India back in 2018. {Read more}

China's BeiDou Navigation Satellite System (BDS), which is being projected as a competitor to the US' Global Position System (GPS), Russia's GLONASS and the European Union's Galileo, is the first to provide regional short message communication service to its users. Through 30 satellites, BDS offers free services to users across the world, according to the official whitepaper titled "China's BeiDou Navigation Satellite System in the New Era". India too is building its navigational system called the Indian Regional Navigation Satellite System (IRNSS), with an operational name of NAVIC. {Read more} Key Points:
