In October 2021, The government has notified Indian Telegraph Right of Way (Amendment) Rules, 2021 to incorporate the provisions related to nominal one-time compensation & uniform procedure for establishment of overground telegraph line in the Indian Telegraph Right of Way Rules, 2016. Earlier the RoW Rules had covered only underground optical fibre cable (OFC) & mobile towers. The amount of one-time compensation for establishment of overground telegraph line has been fixed at maximum ₹1,000 per km. {Read more}

506. On October 26, The Union Cabinet has approved a 3% hike in dearness allowance (DA) for central government employees and dearness relief (DR) for pensioners from existing 28% to 31%. The new rates of DA and DR will be effective from July 1, 2021. The decision will benefit about 47.14 lakh central government employees and 68.62 lakh pensioners. In July 2021, DA rate was increased from 17% to 28%. {Read more}

On October 21, The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) has approved "PM GatiShakti National Master Plan" including institutional framework for rolling out, implementation, monitoring and support mechanism for providing multi-modal connectivity. It was launched by PM Narendra Modi on 13th October, 2021. PM GatiShakti NMP will be monitored in a three-tier system. Implementation framework includes Empowered Group of Secretaries (EGOS), Network Planning Group (NPG) and Technical Support Unit (TSU) with required technical competencies. EGOS will be headed by Cabinet Secretary and will consist of Secretaries of 18 Ministries as members and Head of Logistics Division as Member Convenor. {Read more}

510. On October 21, Former US president Donald Trump announced plans to launch his own social networking platform called "TRUTH Social". The long-awaited platform will be owned by Trump Media & Technology Group (TMTG). {Read more} **Key Points:**

511. On October 18, During the 5 day official visit of External Affairs Minister (EAM) S. Jaishankar to Israel, he paid homage to the victims of the Holocaust in Jerusalem, Israel. India and Israel agreed to resume negotiations on a "Free Trade Agreement (FTA)" from November, 2021 & conclude it by June, 2022. S. Jaishankar visited Israel's 'Ovda Airbase' to meet the Indian contingent participating in the biennial "Blue Flag 2021" exercise involving Air Force missions from 8 countries. He also released a book titled "Bombay/Mumbai: City Heritage Walks" by an India born scholar Prof. Shaul Sapir. {Read more}

On October 21, Pakistan will continue to be on the 'Grey List' of the Financial Action Task Force (FATF) as it needs to further demonstrate that action is being taken against UN-designated terrorists like Hafiz Saeed and Masood Azhar. Three new countries - Turkey, Jordan, and Mali have also been added in the 'Grey List'. While Mauritius and Botswana were removed from the list. In June 2018, Pakistan was placed on the 'Grey List' of jurisdictions under increased monitoring. {Read more}

The central bank also imposed a fine of over ₹27 lakh on cross-border in-bound service operator Western Union Financial Services Inc (WUFSI) for non-compliance with certain provisions of the directions contained in the Master Direction on Money Transfer Service Scheme (MTSS Directions) dated February 22, 2017. {Read more}

Under the scheme, a worker of the organised sector would get a subsidy of 30% on the vehicle's price or Rs 30,000, whichever is less, on the purchase of battery-powered two-wheelers. For workers in the construction sector, the criteria is 50% subsidy or Rs 30,000, whichever is less. Only government-approved 'Made in India' vehicles that are capable of covering a distance of 50 kilometers in one charge are covered under the scheme. {Read more}

523. In October 2021, World Polio Day is observed on October 24 every year to raise awareness for polio vaccination & eradication of polio. Polio is caused by an RNA virus. The World Polio Day was established by 'Rotary International' to commemorate the birth anniversary of Jonas Salk, who led the first team to develop a vaccine against poliomyelitis. {Read more}
