**301.** On October 7, "National Mission on Edible Oil - Oil Palm Business Summit for North Eastern States" was held at Guwahati, Assam. The Mission with a total outlay of Rs 11,040 Cr will bring additional area of 6.5 lakh hectors under Oil Palm plantation with 3.28 lakh hectors in North Eastern states and 3.22 in Rest of India in next 5 years. {Read more}

**302.** On October 6, The Delhi Cabinet has approved its ambitious Health Information Management System (HIMS) project. As part of the project, each citizen will have a Unique Health Card, which will be a repository of their medical information. All citizens between 1 and 18 years would be issued a health card linked to their parent's health card. In a related development, the Cabinet approved ₹48.14 Cr for procurement, distribution and transportation of foodgrains for citizens without ration cards residing in New Delhi. An MoU between IIT Kanpur and the Delhi Pollution Control Committee (DPCC) was also approved by the Cabinet for the technology that will allow accurate information about the real-time source of air pollution in Delhi to be made available. {Read more}

**303.** On October 9, India's Power Ministry has set a revised policy to use Biomass Pellets in coal-burning Thermal Power Plants. It encourages use of Agricultural Waste which is otherwise burnt by farmers, causing air pollution. The decision makes it mandatory for 3 categories of Thermal Power Plants to use a 5% blend of biomass pellets along with coal. The policy will come into force in October 2022, with a requirement to increase the proportion of biomass to 7% within two years for two categories of power plants. The policy for co-firing of biomass would be in force for 25 years or until the useful life of the thermal power plant, whichever is earlier. {Read more}

In UP, 3 lakhs fingerlings were ranched at 3 sites namely, Brijghat, Garhmukteshwar, Tigri, Meerut and Bijnor. National Digital Livestock Mission (NFDB) has sanctioned a total budget of Rs 2.81 Cr to ranch 97.16 lakh fingerlings to different states as a part of Action plan 2020-21 of Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY). {Read more}

It has set a target of vaccinating minimum 1.5 million (15 lakh) people a day. He also declared to provide monetary assistance of ₹50,000 each to the kin of those who died due to Covid-19 infection during the pandemic. The state government has made a provision of ₹700 Cr for the same. {Read more}

While, by amending "National Tariff Policy, 2016", the government authorized 'Imported Coal-based Plants' to operate and sell the un-requisitioned power in the Power Exchange. To boost production, the government has introduced a provision to grant the lease of coal mines for 50 years. {Read more}

The government has launched a Central sector scheme titled "Formation & Promotion of 10,000 Farmer Produce Organizations (FPOs)" to form & promote 10,000 new FPOs in India. Under this scheme a dedicated fund for providing credit guarantees to FPOs has been set up. {Read more}

It is also proposed to introduce a framework for leveraging Geo-tagging technology for capturing exact location information on all existing and new PA infrastructure viz., Point of Sale (PoS) terminals, Quick Response (QR) Codes, etc. Moreover, the RBI's Regulatory Sandbox (RS) has announced 4<sup>th</sup> cohort with the theme of 'Prevention & Mitigation of Financial Frauds'. The RBI also introduced "Internal Ombudsman Scheme" for the NBFCs, while Priority Sector Lending (PSL) facility by Banks to NBFCs was extended till March 31, 2022. {Read more}

**315.** On October 8, Reserve Bank of India (RBI) announced to extend the tap on Special Long-Term Repo Operations (SLTRO) for Small Finance Banks (SFBs) till December 31, 2021. A 3-year SLTRO facility of ₹10,000 Cr at the repo rate was made available to SFBs in May 2021 to be deployed for fresh lending of up to ₹10 lakh per borrower. This facility was made available till October 31, 2021. Besides, in its 4<sup>th</sup> Bi-monthly monetary policy statement, the RBI retained India's GDP for FY22 at 9.5% & India's Consumer Price Index (CPI) inflation in FY22 at 5.3%. While, other rates (RR, RRR, BR, MSF, CRR, SLR) were kept unchanged for the 8<sup>th</sup> consecutive time. {Read more}

321. On October 5, India won 43 medals, including 17 Gold, 16 Silver and 10 Bronze, to finish on top in the ISSF Junior World Championship in Lima. Vijayveer Sidhu, Rhythm Sangwan, Arjun Singh Cheema and Shikha Narwal were India's gold medallists on the final day. Hyderabad teenager Dhanush Srikanth created history by clinching 10m air rifle men's team gold at the ISSF Junior World Championships. He became the first Indian and the only shooter in the world with hearing and speech impairment to win a Gold medal in the regular ISSF World Championships. Moreover, India's Aishwary Pratap Singh Tomar has won Gold in 50m Rifle three positions men's event with a new junior world record at the ISSF Junior World Championships in Lima, Peru. He finished with a record score of 463.4. Earlier in the day, 14-year-old Naamya Kapoor clinched Gold in the women's 25m pistol event while her compatriot Manu Bhaker won bronze. {Read more}
