National & States Affairs

501. On October 19, The Union ministry of education launched the draft of the first 'National Credit Framework' (NCrF) that integrates the credits earned through school education, higher education and vocational and skill education. While a creditbased framework is already in place in technical and higher education, it will be the first time that school and vocational education will be included. According to the draft, credits will be assigned on the basis of learning hours from class 5 to PhD level. So far, it is being considered to set the total hours of learning per credit at 30. The NCrF will be operationalised through the Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) which was launched by UGC in 2021. {Read more} Key Points:

Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan, under Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, has been organizing this programme since 2006 for the development and main streaming of Tribal Youth in collaboration and financial support from Department of Left Wing Extremism (LWE), Ministry of Home Affairs. During this financial year 2022-23, 26 Tribal Youth Exchange Programmes are being organized by NYKS across India. The aim of this programme is to sensitize LWE Tribal Youth to Rich Cultural Heritage of India. {Read more} Key Points:

504. On October 20, Union Education Minister Dharmendra Pradhan launched the "National Curriculum Framework (NCF) 2022" for foundational stage education of children in the 3 to 8 years age group. Early Childhood Care and Education are key areas of development, according to the 2022 framework. The NCF 2022 has 4 sections - the National Curriculum Framework for School Education, the National Curriculum Framework for Early Childhood Care and Education, the National Curriculum Framework for Teacher Education and the National Curriculum Framework for Adult Education. The framework has listed the 'Panchakosha' concept for Education of children and its 5 parts are physical development (sharirik vikas), development of life energy (pranik vikas), emotional and mental development (manasik vikas), intellectual development (bauddhik vikas) and spiritual development (chaitsik vikas). Moreover, 'Vidya Pravesh' (Entry Level Education) has been developed by the NCERT for students entering class 1. {Read more}

On October 18, The Assam government and the US Agency for International Development (USAID) launched the "trees outside forests in India (TOFI)" programme for bringing farmers, companies, and private institutions together to expand the tree coverage outside of traditional forests in the State. Assam is one of seven States where the US will allocate up to \$25 million under the TOFI programme. The other States are Andhra Pradesh, Haryana, Odisha, Rajasthan, Tamil Nadu, and Uttar Pradesh. Through agroforestry, or integrating trees into farming systems, TOFI will improve the resilience of farming systems, while increasing the income of farmers in Assam. {Read more} **Key Points:**

506. On October 22, Kerala Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan launched the "Kunjapp", a mobile application to prevent cybercrimes against children in the state. The CM also inaugurated the training for the newly appointed Child Welfare Committee (CWC) and Juvenile Justice Board (JJB) members at Kovalam near Thiruvananthapuram. {Read more} Key Points:

507. On October 22, Netherlands surpassed China and became India's third-largest export market. Brazil, which occupied the 21st spot in FY22, is now India's 8th biggest export market. US and the UAE continue to be the largest and second-largest export destinations, respectively, for India. The exports to the US climbed 18.3% until August to \$35.2 billion, while those to the UAE shot up 27.3% to \$13.8 billion. {Read more}

The facility is South Asia's first state-of-the-art, most advanced model of Cath Lab and the IGS 6 from Wipro GE Healthcare is the first AutoRight[™] enabled Cath Lab in India. The facility will be useful for coronary interventions like coronary angiography & angioplasty, neurology interventions like carotid angiography and angioplasty, electrophysiology studies, Transcutaneous Aortic Valve replacements (TAVR) etc. {Read more}

510. On October 21, India received its first Migration Monitoring System called "Migration Tracking System (MTS)". The system is aimed at providing updated information on migrant pregnant women, lactating mothers and children instantly on a single system. The system, developed by the Department of Women and Child Development was inaugurated in Mumbai by Maharashtra Women and Child Development Minister Mangalprabhat Lodha. The website-based Migration Tracking System (MTS) will track the movements of vulnerable seasonal migrant beneficiaries through individual unique identification numbers. The first-of-its-kind system will make available the information of seasonal migrant women and children immediately. {Read more}

On October 20, Global leaders confirmed US\$ 2.6 billion in funding toward the Global Polio Eradication Initiative's (GPEI) 2022-2026 Strategy to end polio at a pledging moment co-hosted by Germany's Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ) at the World Health Summit in Berlin. UNICEF pledged US\$ 5 million and United States pledged US\$ 114 million whereas Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation pledged US\$S 1.2 billion at the summit. Wild poliovirus is endemic in just two countries, Pakistan and Afghanistan. {Read more} Key Points:

512. On October 22, Australia and Japan signed a security pact to share sensitive intelligence and deepen defence cooperation to counter China's military rise. Under the deal, both countries' defence forces will train together in Northern Australia and expand and strengthen cooperation across defence. This will strengthen the framework of the Quad (Australia, India, Japan and the United States) and is the first step for Japan to join the Five Eyes. {Read more}

513. On October 20, The Interpol unveiled the first-ever 'metaverse' specifically designed for law enforcement worldwide, at its ongoing 90th General Assembly in Delhi. The Interpol metaverse allows the registered users to take a virtual tour of its general secretariat headquarters in France's Lyon. The facility is being provided through the global police organisation's secure cloud. World Economic Forum has partnered with Interpol, Meta, Microsoft and others in an initiative to define and govern the metaverse. {Read more}

On October 21, after more than 4 years, Financial Action Task Force (FATF) removed Pakistan from its 'Grey List' after giving it a clean bill of health over its financial reforms combating terror financing. The decision was taken during the 2-day Plenary of the FATF held under the Presidency of T. Raja Kumar in Paris, France. Since 2018, Pakistan had been on the list of FATF's 'Jurisdictions under Increased Monitoring', known colloquially as the 'grey list'. Along with Pakistan, FATF also removed Nicaragua, while adding DR Congo, Tanzania and Mozambique to the 'grey list'. The international watchdog added Myanmar to the 'black list', which already included North Korea and Iran. {Read more}

515. On October 19, International Solar Alliance (ISA), in its General Assembly meeting, approved the 'Solar Facility', a payment guarantee mechanism expected to stimulate investments into solar projects through two financial components, a Solar Payment Guarantee Fund and Solar Insurance Fund. The thrust of the facility is to attract private capital to flow into underserved markets" in Africa. {Read more}

516. On October 19, Prime Minister Narendra Modi laid the foundation stone for a new air base at Deesa in Banaskantha district of north Gujarat near the India-Pakistan border. The air base will reduce the gap of 355 Kms between the Air Force station in Bhuj and Uttarlai. The development of the airbase will be done in two phases at an approximate cost of Rs 980 Cr by December, 2023. The land was acquired back in 1983 and approval to construct a full-fledged air base was given by Centre in 2020. {Read more}

'Tiger Triumph' was a table-top simulation of joint response to provide disaster relief services to a notional third country that experienced a super-cyclone, by Indian and U.S. military and diplomatic representatives. This exercise was the second edition and the first edition took place in 2019 in Visakhapatnam. {Read more}

519. On October 20, Late Hollywood actress and fashion icon Anna May Wong (1905-1961) became the first Asian American to feature on US currency. Regarded as the film industry's first Chinese-American star, Wong's decades-long career in motion pictures, television and theatre came at a time of widespread racism. She was born with the birth name Wong Liu-Tsong. The quarter-dollar coin, which features Anna May Wong, also includes the Latin phrase "E PLURIBUS UNUM" (out of many, one). {Read more}

Science & Technology

520. The Chandrayaan-3 mission is expected to be launched in August 2023. The design and engineering are significantly different, compared to Chandrayaan-2, to make it more robust and avoid the problems from last time. The Chandrayaan-3 mission is a follow-up of Chandrayaan-2 of July 2019, which aimed to land a rover on the lunar South Pole and lander Vikram, instead of a controlled landing, ended up crash-landing on September 7, 2019, and prevented rover Pragyaan from successfully travelling on the surface of the moon. On October 23, ISRO launched OneWeb's 36 satellites aboard its heaviest rocket LVM3, earlier known as the GSLV Mk3. {Read more}

- Chandrayaan-2 launched in July 2019 & ended up crash-landing on Lunar South Pole with lander Vikram
- ISRO launched OneWeb's 36 satellites aboard its heaviest rocket 'LVM3'

521. On October 21, Aircraft manufacturer Airbus received approval from India's aviation regulator, Directorate General of Aeronautical Quality Assurance (DGAQA), for its C295 aircraft programme. In September, Indian government signed a Rs 21,00 Crore deal with Airbus Defence and Space to procure 56 C295 transport aircrafts. Airbus plans to replace the Indian Air Force's ageing Avro-748 planes. Airbus becomes the first foreign original equipment maker to get such approval. Under the agreement, the European manufacturer Airbus will deliver 16 aircraft ready to fly within 4 years, while the remaining 40 will be manufactured and assembled by Tata Advanced Systems (TASL) in India as part of an industrial partnership between the two companies. India has approved Airbus' Defence and Space Quality Management System (QMS) for the C295 aircraft, which is a first for the country. {Read more}

- Airbus received approval from DGAQA for its C295 aircraft programme (C295 aircrafts will replace Avro-748 planes)
- In September, Indian Govt signed a Rs 21,00 Crore deal with Airbus to procure 56 'C295 transport aircrafts'
- Out of 56 aircrafts, 40 will be manufactured and assembled by Tata Advanced Systems

522. On October 21, The Indian Institute of Technology-Madras and NASA Jet Propulsion Laboratory (JPL) researchers have studied the interactions between microbes in the International Space Station (ISS). A microbe that resides on the ISS, was found to be beneficial to various other microorganisms but hampered the growth of Aspergillus fungus. The study would help devise strategies for the disinfection of space stations to minimise any potential impact of microbes on the health of astronauts. {Read more}

523. On October 21, A new species of grasshopper, which has been identified from Tamil Nadu, is named after the Dravidian landscape. The newly described pygmy unicorn grasshopper "Dravidacris annamalaica" is restricted to the eastern coast of Tamil Nadu. The discovery was published in the Zootaxa journal. Dravidacris annamalaica is now in the checklist of Indian orthoptera and among the 500-odd species under 89 genera of Metrodorinae grasshopper subfamily in the world. {Read more}
