601. On October 25, Agriculture Ministry has set up two committees to make nation-wide crop yield estimation and improve weather data infrastructure. The move will reduce the delay in crop loss/damage estimation and ensure timely settlement of claims by farmers. The panels will be headed by Dr. C. S. Murthy, the director of Mahalanobis National Crop Forecast Centre (MNCFC). The committee has been tasked to help the Ministry in the creation of the proposed 'Weather Information Network Data System (WINDS)', under which a system of automatic weather stations (AWS) and automatic rain gauges (ARG) will be implemented throughout the country. {Read more}

602. On October 27, the Central government has officially restricted the use of the widely used herbicide, Glyphosate, fearing risk to human and animal health. From now, glyphosate will be applied only through pest control operators (PCOs). PCOs are licensed to use deadly chemicals for treating pests such as rodents. Glyphosate has been majorly used in tea plantations in India where it is applied to control herbicides. The World Health Organization (WHO) and the International Agency for Research on Cancer (IARC) published a study in 2015 that said glyphosate is 'probably carcinogenic to humans'. {Read more}

603. On October 26, Odisha launched a common credit portal 'SAFAL' (Simplified Application for Agricultural Loans) for the welfare of farmers. SAFAL will also provide the government with complete visibility of demand and disbursal of formal credit across states and ensure schemes are designed in a data-backed manner. {Read more}

604. On October 26, as part of 'Project Suryagram' (Sun Village), Gujarat's Modhera has emerged as India's first solarpowered village. It is also a 'net-zero' energy community, meeting 100% of its energy requirements using on-site solar power. Under the project, 1 kilowatt (KW) solar panels have been installed on the roof of almost every house in Modhera in two phases. Apart from panels, the Gujarat Power Corporation Ltd (GPCL) has set up a 6 MW ground-mounted solar power plant with a 15 MWh Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) at Sujjanpura near Modhera. {Read more} **Key Points:**

The campaign was initially launched by Minister of Jal Shakti, Gajendra Singh Shekhawat, on October 2, 2020. The motto of the Jal Jeevan Mission is 'No One is Left Out'. Goa and Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu (D&NH and D&D) had become the first 'Har Ghar Jal' certified State and UT in India, respectively. While Madhya Pradesh's Burhanpur is the first 'Har Ghar Jal' certified district in India. {Read more}

On October 26, Cognizant expanded its collaboration with chipmaker Qualcomm to open a 5G experience center in Atlanta, the first such center in North America which will focus on use cases in manufacturing and supply chain management. The new Atlanta experience center builds on Cognizant's 5G center in Bangalore, India. {Read more} Key Points:

Indian Army had organised special bike rallies for the day across the country in Jammu (Jammu and Kashmir), Shillong (Meghalaya), Wellington (Tamil Nadu), and Ahmedabad (Gujarat). The endpoint was New Delhi to join the day's celebrations at the National War Memorial. {Read more} Key Points:

610. On October 26, Microsoft has launched an ARM-powered Mac Mini-like desktop PC dubbed "Windows Dev Kit 2023" that is designed to help developers build and create apps for Windows on ARM machines. This system is codenamed "Project Volterra" and was unveiled earlier in May, 2022. The device is available in 8 countries which include Australia, China, Canada, Germany, Japan, the UK, China, France and the US. It is powered by the Snapdragon 8cx Gen 3 Compute Platform and backed by the Qualcomm Neural Processing SDK. {Read more}

611. On October 27, The United States decided to retrieve older HAWK air defence equipment from storage to send to Ukraine which is facing a heavy barrage of Russian drone-fired and cruise missiles. The HAWK interceptor missiles would be an upgrade to the Stinger missile system, which US sent to Ukraine early on in the war. HAWK (Homing All the Way Killer) entered service with the US Army in 1959, during the Vietnam war. The HAWK system was the predecessor to the PATRIOT missile defence system that Raytheon built in the 1990s. {Read more}

This can create a vibrant gold ecosystem in India by enabling actual fungibility of gold. India is the second largest consumer of gold globally with annual gold demand of approximately 800-900 tonne and holds an important position in the global markets. {Read more}

The Bima Sugam platform will provide all these facilities to policyholders with an e-insurance account (E-IA). The platform will also help reduce commissions paid to intermediaries. The major stakeholders in Bima Sugam will be Life Insurance Council (30%), General Insurance Council at (30%), Online PSBs-Public Sector Banks (35%) and Brokers Association (5%). {Read more}

On October 26, Naval Innovation Indigenisation Organisation (NIIO) under the Indian Navy and Drone Federation of India (DFI) have joined hands to collaboratively work towards promoting indigenous development, manufacturing and testing of a drone, counter-drone. The Drone Federation of India is a non-government, not-for-profit, industry-led body that promotes the drone industry by creating business opportunities, developing a robust skilling infrastructure, developing standards, and promoting R&D efforts. A special maritime drone testing site shall also be earmarked for the Indian drone industry to facilitate faster development and testing of drones. {Read more}

617. On October 27, Tata, an Indian multinational conglomerate, and Airbus will jointly manufacture 'C-295' transport aircraft for the Indian Air Force in Vadodara, Gujarat. The deal, worth Rs 21,000 crore, was signed between the Ministry of Defence (MoD) and the European aerospace/defense major Airbus for the purchase of 56 C-295 aircraft. It is a joint venture between Tatas and Airbus. Airbus will deliver the first 16 aircraft in 'fly-away' condition from its final assembly line in Seville, Spain within 4 years, and the subsequent 40 aircraft will be manufactured and assembled in India by Tata Advanced Systems (TASL). {Read more}

Before this, between November 8 and 18, the member countries of the Quad (US, Japan, Australia & India) will conduct the "Malabar" exercise off Yokosuka in Japan. The US and Indian forces had concluded the "Vajra Prahar" exercise at Bakloh in Himachal Pradesh in August. India will also conduct the "Austra-Hind" infantry combat exercise at the Mahajan range in Rajasthan between November 28 and December 11. Recently, the two countries concluded the "Pitch Black" air combat exercise at Darwin. Moreover, India and Singapore will also conduct the "Agni Warrior" exercise at Deolali in Maharashtra between November 13 and 30. {Read more}

The combined pledges made by countries to fight the climate crisis are insufficient to meet the Paris Agreement goal of limiting global warming to below 1.5°C, according to the "NDC Synthesis Report 2022" released by United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC). Ambitious climate action before 2030 is urgently needed to achieve the long-term goals of the Paris Agreement. If average temperatures exceed 2°C, compared to pre-industrial levels, the world will face fiercer storms, higher seas, melting ice and more people dying from heat. The Paris Agreement was adopted by 196 Parties at COP 21 in Paris, on 12 December, 2015 and entered into force on 4 November, 2016. Its goal is to limit global warming to well below 2 degrees Celsius, preferably to 1.5 degrees Celsius, compared to pre-industrial levels. {Read more}

At 2.4 tCO2e (tonne carbon dioxide equivalent), India's per capita greenhouse gas emissions were far below the world average of 6.3 tCO2e in 2020, according to a new report titled "Emissions Gap Report 2022: The Closing Window" released by the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) on October 27. The US remains far above this level at 14 tCO2e, followed by 13 tCO2e in Russia, and 9.7 tCO2e in China. The report is released ahead of the UN Climate Change conference (COP27) in Egypt in November 2022. The report also stated that the international community is still falling far short of the Paris goals, with no credible pathway to limiting global temperature rise to 1.5 degree Celsius in place. Current policies alone would lead to a 2.8 degrees Celsius hike. To get on a least-cost pathway to holding global warming to 1.5 degree Celsius, emissions must fall by 45% over those envisaged under current policies by 2030. For the two degrees Celsius target, a 30% cut is needed. India's contribution to historical cumulative CO2 emissions (excluding LULUCF) is 3%, whereas the US and the EU have contributed 25% and 17% respectively to total fossil CO2 emissions from 1850 to 2019. {Read more}
