

National & States Affairs

601. On September 23, the Assam government decided to use the air pressure machine 'SAANS' across its hospitals to reduce neonatal mortality. 'SAANS' is a portable neonatal Continuous Positive Air Pressure (CPAP) system that can provide lifesaving breathing support to infants in hospital settings as well as during travel. This machine is developed by a Bangalore-based start-up InnAccel Technologies. For the development of the machine, InnAccel Technologies, incubated at the Centre for Cellular and Molecular Platforms (C-CAMP), partnered with the SAMRIDH Healthcare Blended Finance Facility to strengthen respiratory support for newborns and pediatric populations in Assam. SAMRIDH is a multi-stakeholder innovation and financing platform supported by the USAID. {Read more}

602. On September 21, Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman launched "Bharat Vidya", an online learning platform for Oriental and South Asian studies. Designed and developed by the Bhandarkar Oriental Research Institute (BORI), Bharat Vidya is a first-of-its-kind online platform, which will offer both free and paid courses covering various aspects of Indology pertaining to art, architecture, philosophy, language and science. Six course were announced - Veda Vidya, Bharatiya Darshanshashtra, Sanskrit learning, 18 Parvas of Mahabharata, Fundamentals of Archaeology, and Kalidasa & Bhasha. {Read more}

Mehta is the founder and Chairman of the National Solar Energy Federation of India (NSEFI) and Director of the Global Solar Council. Moreover, during the CEM 13, it was announced that India will host the 14th edition of the Clean Energy Ministerial (CEM) in July, 2023. {Read more}

In an effort to include the common man more directly in the development of the state, Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath announced to launch the "Uttar Pradesh Matrabhumi Yojana" portal on the occasion of the birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi on October 2. Under the scheme, the government will bear 40% of the total cost of the project, including construction of a community building, hospital, school, or common service center while the remaining 60% will be contributed by the people interested. {Read more}

The RTIS is developed in collaboration with the ISRO. They get automatically plotted on the control chart of those trains in the Control Office Application (COA) system. RTIS devices have been installed for 2700 locomotives in 21 electric loco sheds. {Read more} **Key Points:**

607. On September 23, the 9th meeting of the Joint Committee on Water Resources (JCWR) was held in Kathmandu, Nepal. The meeting was co-chaired by Pankaj Kumar, Secretary, Department of Water Resources, River Development and Ganga Rejuvenation, Ministry of Jal Shakti. This was preceded by the 7th meeting of the Joint Standing Technical Committee on Water Resources on September 21-22. This meeting was co-chaired by M. K. Srinivas, Chairman, Ganga Flood Control Commission, Patna. These meetings comprehensively reviewed the bilateral water-sector cooperation between India and Nepal, including the implementation of the Mahakali Treaty, the Sapta Kosi-Sun Kosi Project and cooperation in areas of flooding and inundation. The Mahakali Treaty was signed in 1996 over the integrated development of the Mahakali River. Sapta Kosi High Dam is a multipurpose project proposed to be constructed on the Saptakosi River of Nepal. {Read more} Key Points:

608. On September 24, the Ministry Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEFCC) is set to launch "Swachh Vayu Sarvekshan" that promotes ranking of 131 cities in India for implementing City Action Plans prepared as part of National Clean Air Programme (NCAP) for reducing air pollution up to 40% by 2025-26. 131 cities are categorized into three groups based on population. Cities are required to do the self-assessment as per the framework provided on PRANA online portal. This assessment is carried out annually. Cities have to report implementation of activities and measures taken in respect of solid waste management, road dust management, management of construction and demolition waste, control of vehicular emissions and industrial pollution. It was informed that based on the self-assessment and third party assessment, 3 best performing cities in each group will be given cash award. {Read more}

609. On September 26, Odisha Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik released 5 edited Volumes of "Encyclopaedia of Tribes in Odisha" published by Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes Research and Training Institute (SCSTRTI) and Odisha State Tribal Museum. Odisha is the only State till now to publish an Encyclopaedia of all Tribes. The encyclopaedia contains 418 research articles on the tribals. {Read more}

On September 27, Uttar Pradesh was awarded the "Ayushman Utkrishtata Award 2022" at the 'Aarogya Manthan' programme held in Delhi for adding various facilities to the National Health Facility Register (NHFR). Uttar Pradesh has opened around 2 Crore Ayushman Bharat Health Accounts (ABHA), making it the second state in the nation to do so. According to a government release, UP was the Best Performing State in the nation after it added 28,728 new health facilities to the National Health Facility Register. Karnataka ranked second with 23,838 healthcare facilities, followed by Andhra Pradesh (13,335). The users of eSanjeevani can create their 14-digit unique Ayushman Bharat Health Account (ABHA) number and use it to link their existing health records. {Read more}

611. In September 2022, the Global Climate Strikes were organised under the banner of "Fridays for Future (FFF)" campaign, a youth-led Climate Justice Movement. Thousands of young activists took to the streets across the world September 23, 2022, demanding stronger policies for loss and damage as well as climate reparation from governments in their countries. The campaign focused on providing a platform for the most affected people and areas (MAPA) to voice their demands. The global movement took place a day after 'Loss & Damage Action Day' on September 22. {Read more}

612. On September 23, the QUAD grouping decided to expand their scope of partnership with the signing of "Humanitarian Assistance and Disaster Relief (HADR)" partnership guidelines during a ministerial meeting hosted by the US on the sidelines of the United Nations General Assembly (UNGA) in New York. Union Minister of External Affairs S. Jaishankar participated in the meeting and termed HADR very timely. 615. On September 24, the Indian Army and the Defence Geoinformatics and Research Establishment (DGRE) jointly installed the "Avalanche Monitoring Radar", first of its kind in India, in Sikkim. This radar has the capability to detect avalanches within three seconds of their triggering and will assist in saving valuable life of troops and civilians as also vehicles in super high altitude areas. Besides being used for detection of avalanches, this radar can also be employed to detect landslides. {Read more}

616. On September 22, the Ministry of Defence (MoD) signed a contract with BrahMos Aerospace Pvt Ltd (BAPL) for acquisition of additional dual-role capable Surface to Surface BrahMos missiles at an overall approximate cost of Rs 1700 Cr under "Buy-Indian" Category. In March this year, India had successfully test-fired surface-to-surface cruise missile BrahMos at Andaman and Nicobar Island. The range of the advanced version of this BrahMos missile was extended to around 350 km from the original 290 km. BrahMos missile flies at a speed of 2.8 Mach or almost three times the speed of sound. {Read more}

On September 24, Jhulan Goswami of West Bengal, the highest wicket-taker in women's ODI history, announced to retire from International Cricket after the final match of the ODI series between India and England. She made her debutant in international cricket on January 6, 2002 (ODI). She is regarded as one of the greatest fast bowlers in the history of women's cricket. She has to her name 253 ODI wickets (till the time of publishing the article), 44 Test wickets and 56 T20I wickets. "Chakda Xpress" is the biopic of Jhulan Goswami. {Read more}

It is a domestic first-class cricket competition played in India and named after Kumar Shri Duleepsinhji of Nawanagar (Jamnagar). {Read more}

619. On September 25, Jews throughout the globe started celebrating the Jewish New Year, popularly called "Rosh Hashanah". Rosh Hashanah is considered one of the holiest days in Judaism which begins on the first day of the Tishrei, the Hebrew calendar's seventh month. Interestingly, Tishrei almost always coincides with September or October every year. The festival, meaning 'first of the year' or 'head of the year', is a time for reflection for all Jews. {Read more}

Science & Technology

620. In September 2022, the NASA's "DART" (Double Asteroid Redirection Test) spacecraft successfully crashed into the asteroid Dimorphos. Scientists expect the impact to alter the asteroid's orbit/route. However, it will take a few weeks before NASA can determine how much the asteroid's path was changed due to the impact. Scientists don't yet know the exact mass of Dimorphos but it is estimated to be around 5 billion kilograms. The DART spacecraft weighs around 600 kilograms. {Read more}

621. In September 2020, Chinese researchers have discovered "Changesite-(Y)", a new mineral on Moon. It is a phosphate mineral in columnar crystals found in lunar basalt particles. Changesite-(Y) is the sixth mineral discovered on the Moon by humans. The diamond-shaped mineral was found in the samples returned from the Moon by the Chang'e-5 lunar probe in 2020. {Read more}

622. On September 25, "NROL-91", a classified spy satellite for the U.S. National Reconnaissance Office, was launched into orbit aboard a 'United Launch Alliance (ULA) Delta 4 Heavy rocket'. The satellite lifted off from Vandenberg Space Force Base in California's Santa Barbara County. This was the 387th flight of a Delta rocket since 1960 and the 95th and final launch from Vandenberg. {Read more}

623. On September 26, China launched a Kuaizhou-1A carrier rocket to place two satellites namely - Shiyan-14 and Shiyan-15, in space. The pair of satellites was lifted off from the Taiyuan Satellite Launch Center in the northern province of Shanxi. The Shiyan-14 will mainly be used to conduct scientific experiments and verify new technologies, while the Shiyan-15 will provide data in the fields of land survey, urban planning, and disaster prevention and mitigation. It was the 18th flight mission of the Kuaizhou-1A series rockets. {Read more}

624. On September 22, an indigenous loitering munition named "ALS 50", capable of operating from difficult terrain and high altitude areas, was successfully tested at Pokhran, Rajasthan. Developed by Tata Advanced Systems Limited (TASL), the autonomous system is designed for Vertical Take Off and Landing (VTOL) and will soon be inducted into the Armed Forces. {Read more}

Awards, Rewards, Recognition & Prizes

629. On September 23, the winners of the "2023 Breakthrough Prizes", dubbed the "Oscars of Science", were announced. Three prizes were awarded this year in the life sciences category, one for mathematics and one for physics. The Breakthrough Prize in Mathematics was awarded to Daniel Spielman. The prize in Fundamental Physics was shared by Charles Bennett, Gilles Brassard, David Deutsch and Peter Shor for their work in quantum information. Clifford Brangwynne and Anthony Hyman won a Life Sciences Prize for discovering a new mechanism of cellular organization. The other Life Sciences Prizes were awarded to Demis Hassabis and John Jumper for developing AlphaFold. The Breakthrough Prizes, created in 2010 by a group of Silicon Valley entrepreneurs, are the most richly endowed awards in science, disbursing more than the Nobel prizes. {Read more}

The 42-year-old barrister, was appointed to the UK Cabinet earlier in September, by British Prime Minister Liz Truss. {Read more}

India's Under 5 Mortality Rate (U5MR) (per 1,000 live births) stood at 32 in 2020 (ranges from 36 in rural areas to 21 in urban areas).
