1. On September 2, Karnataka government launched the Global Startup Challenge - "VentuRISE" to support growth stage startups in manufacturing and sustainability-related sectors. VentuRISE will be a part of the Global Investors Meeţ, "Invest Karnataka 2022", which will be held from 2-4 November in Bengaluru. The global challenge will help entrepreneurs across the globe with a platform to showcase their innovative products or solutions and connect with potential investors. A cash prize of \$1,00,000 is earmarked for the winners. {Read more}

Moreover, an 'e-Transfer' software has been developed to bring transparency in the transfer of CAPF personnel. Besides, the Government of India has also started the 'Ayushman CAPF' scheme to provide better medical facilities to families of Jawans, under which more than 35 lakh Ayushman Cards have been distributed to 10 lakh personnel. {Read more}

The Scheme, with a financial outlay of Rs 3,000 Crore notified in 2020, aims to bring down the cost of manufacturing of bulk drugs by creation of world class common infrastructure facilities supported by the Central Government. The Indian Pharmaceutical industry is the 3rd largest in the world by volume. India exported pharmaceuticals worth Rs 1,75,040 Cr in the financial year 2021-22, including Bulk Drugs/Drug Intermediates worth Rs 33,320 Cr. {Read more}

The committee will study major cyber-attack incidents related to financial markets in domestic and global markets and identify gaps in the existing cyber security and cyber resilience framework. {Read more}

Cervical cancer is the 4th most common cancer among women globally, according to the WHO. Cervavac was developed by the Pune-based Serum Institute of India (SII) in coordination with the Government of India's Department of Biotechnology (DBT). Cervavac received market authorisation approval from the Drug Controller General of India (DCGI) on July 12, 2022. {Read more}

While the unemployment was the lowest in Chhattisgarh at 0.4%. {Read more}
