

101. On September 6, Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY) approved an Electronics Manufacturing Cluster (EMC) in Ranjangaon Phase III in Pune at a cost of Rs 500 Cr. The central government assistance for the project would be nearly Rs 208 Cr. The modified EMC 2.0 scheme was notified on April 1, 2020. {Read more}

National e-Governance Division (NeGD), under Ministry of Electronics & IT (MeitY) organised the 30th batch of "Chief Information Security Officers' (CISOs) Deep Dive Training Programme" in New Delhi under Cyber Surakshit Bharat Initiative. Cyber Surakshit Bharat initiative was conceptualised with the mission to spread awareness about cyber-crime and build capacities of CISOs and frontline IT officials, across all government departments. Launched in 2018, the CISO training is the first-of-its-kind of partnership between the Government and industry consortium under Public Private Partnership (PPP) model. {Read more}

It was set up in September 2019 to promote Ease of Living in India. The 11-member CLC was set up under the Chairmanship of the MCA Secretary (Tarun Bajaj at present). Revenue Secretary Tarun Bajaj was given additional charge of MCA Secretary in August 2022. {Read more}

In the last revision effective April 1, 2022, the price of natural gas from old and regulated fields was doubled to \$6.1 per million British thermal unit (mBtu). Of natural gas consumed in India, almost 50% is imported LNG. {Read more}

Karnataka is the first State in southern India and only the second state in the country to get the CZMP prepared and approved as per the new CRZ notification. Moreover, the Government has given approval for the development of Maajali Port in Karwar at a cost of Rs 350 Cr. Under Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada scheme, the Central Government has given approval to supply 100 high speed boats to help deep sea fishing. {Read more}

106. On September 6, the Union Environment Ministry has extended the deadlines for Thermal Power Plants to install pollution control technologies and comply with new emission norms. This is the third time that the deadlines have been pushed in the last 5 years. The deadline for the power plants within a 10-km radius of Delhi-NCR and cities with a population of more than 10 lakh has been extended from December 31, 2022 to December 31, 2024. For the power plants within a 10-km radius of critically-polluted areas or non-attainment cities, the deadline has been pushed from December 31, 2023 to December 31, 2025. For all other power plants across the country, the deadline has been pushed from December 31, 2024 to December 31, 2026. {Read more}

107. Indian Army achieved a remarkable feat by constructing a bridge in 6 days. The construction of the bailey bridge over Sukhtawa river in Narmadapuram, Madhya Pradesh was completed by the Engineers of the Sudarshan Chakra Corps of Indian Army on August 31. The 145-year-old bridge had collapsed in April 2022 due to heavy vehicle traffic. The construction of this bridge will restore the connectivity on NH 46 connecting Bhopal with Nagpur. {Read more}

108. Ladakh is all set to get India's first geothermal power project soon to tap the potential of natural geysers dotting the Puga area/valley, 170 km east of Leh and in Changthang plains. Oil and Natural Gas Corporation (ONGC) has embarked upon a journey to generate electricity on a utility scale by tapping steam gushing from the earth's bowels at Puga, a remote valley located at an altitude of over 14,000 feet, off the road to Chumar on the de-facto border with China. This will be India's first geothermal energy project and also the world's highest. {Read more}
