On September 10, Kibithu Military Garrison (Arunachal Pradesh) on the banks of Lohit Valley along the Line of Actual Control (LAC) and a 22 Km-road in this mountain hamlet were named after India's first Chief of Defence Staff Gen Bipin Rawat. As a young Colonel, Rawat had commanded his Battalion 5/11 Gorkha Rifles at Kibithu from 1999-2000. The 22 km road stretch from Walong to Kibithu was dedicated as Gen Bipin Rawat Marg by Chief Minister Pema Khandu. A majestic life-size mural of Gen Rawat was also unveiled. Gen Rawat was killed in a helicopter crash near Coonoor in Tamil Nadu on December 8 last year. {Read more}

The Parameswaran Iyer-headed committee approved the first incentive for mobile manufacturing under the PLI scheme for large scale electronics manufacturing. This is the first-ever disbursement under any PLI scheme. The government has already rolled out the scheme with an outlay of about Rs 2 Lakh Cr for as many as 14 sectors, including automobiles and auto components, white goods, pharma, textiles, advance chemistry cell and speciality steel. {Read more} **Key Points:**

In the new design of Vande Bharat Express, photo-catalytic ultra violet air purification system is installed in the roof mounted Roof Mounted Package Unit (RMPU) for air purification. The first Vande Bharat Express was launched by PM Narendra Modi on 15 February 2019. {Read more}

India is currently part of the G20 Troika (current, previous and incoming G20 Presidencies) comprising Indonesia, Italy and India. The HTS broadband service from Hughes combines Ku-band capacity from ISRO GSAT-11 and GSAT-29 satellites with Hughes JUPITER Platform ground technology to deliver high-speed broadband. {Read more}
