**401.** On September 18, the Bihar government has decided to introduce "No-bag Day" rule in schools along with a mandatory games period at least once a week in order to lighten the load on students. The policy is being brought to engage students in activities that can positively impact their learning. The day will be devoted to practical and experiential learning. The new initiative by the state government is in line with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2022. {Read more}

In line with National Education Policy-2020, this program will provide an opportunity to students, faculties, entrepreneurs, innovators and others to showcase innovative approaches and technology solutions to promote innovation for crop improvement. During 2020-21 & 2021-22, NAHEP in association with Agricultural Engineering and Animal Science Divisions of ICAR organized Hackathon 1.0 and 2.0 to promote the innovation in Farm Mechanization and in Animal Science, respectively. ICAR commenced NAHEP with the assistance of World Bank (WB) in November 2017. {Read more}

**404.** According to the government's data, India has turned into a power surplus nation with a total installed electricity capacity of over 4 lakh MW. Today, India is the world's third largest producer of renewable energy, with 40% of its installed electricity capacity coming from non-fossil fuel sources. Power Generation from Renewable Energy Sources has increased from 51,226 GW hours to 1,38,337 GW hours in 2020. India's vision is to achieve Net Zero Emissions by 2070, in addition to attaining the short-term targets including increasing renewables capacity to 500 GW by 2030 and meeting 50% of energy requirements from renewables. {Read more}

**408.** In September 2022, The Reef-World Foundation in partnership with the UN Environment Programme (UNEP) developed the "Green Fins Hub", the first-ever global marine tourism industry platform. The industry-backed digital platform is expected to scale up reach from about 700 operators across 14 countries today to a potential 30,000 worldwide. The platform will overcome the biggest sustainability challenges in the marine conservation tourism industry. {Read more}

**409.** On September 16, Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) has again revised the definition of "small companies" under the Companies Act, 2013 by increasing their thresholds for paid up capital from "not exceeding Rs 2 Crore" to "not exceeding Rs 4 Crore" and turnover from "not exceeding Rs 20 Crore" to "not exceeding Rs 40 crore". The latest revision aims to facilitate Ease of Doing Business further and reduce compliance burden on "small companies". {Read more}

PM Narendra Modi had participated in the Summit. Varanasi will promote tourism, cultural and humanitarian exchanges between India and the SCO member Countries. {Read more}

**411.** On September 22, The Supreme Court appointed former apex court judge Justice L Nageswara Rao for amending constitution of Indian Olympic Association and preparing electoral college. Justice Rao has been asked to prepare a road map for amending the constitution and holding elections by December 15, 2022. The International Olympic Committee (IOC) on September 8 issued a final warning to IOA to "resolve its governance issues" and hold elections by December, failing which the world sports body will ban India. Rajeev Mehta is currently the Secretary General of IOA & Adille Sumariwalla is the vice president of IOA. {Read more}

**412.** On September 17, Indian government launched the "National Logistics Policy (NLP)" framework to become globally competitive. The Unified Logistics Interface Platform (ULIP) will bring all the digital services related to the transportation sector into a single portal, freeing the exporters from a host of very long and cumbersome processes. The policy will help bring down the transportation, warehousing and inventory costs, which will consequently reduce the overall logistics cost down to around 8% of GDP in the next 5 years. India aims to become a \$5 trillion economy by 2024-25. Notably, the government's latest policy comes with a Comprehensive Logistics Action Plan (CLAP) which details the NLP's specific targets. These include: Reducing India's logistics cost to be comparable to global benchmarks by 2030 and aiming to be among the top 25 countries by 2030 in the Logistics Performance Index (LPI). {Read more}

**413.** On September 21, Amazon announced its first Utility-scale Renewable Energy projects in India, three solar farms located in Rajasthan. These include a 210 MW project to be developed by ReNew Power, a 100MW project to be developed by local developer Amp Energy India, and a 110MW project to be developed by Brookfield Renewable. These solar farms have combined capacity to generate 1,076,000 megawatt hours (MWh) of renewable energy per year. Additionally, Amazon announced 23 new solar rooftop projects on its fulfillment centers across 14 cities in India. {Read more}

Duur Se Namaste, a fictional Hindi series developed in an entertainment-education format, highlights the challenges of a post-pandemic world and promotes the adoption of healthy behaviours and practices. The series is produced by National Film Award winner and Padma Shri awardee, Nil Madhav Panda's production house, Elleeanora Images Pvt Ltd. {Read more}

**416.** On September 15, the Minister of State for Electronics and Information Technology, Rajeev Chandrasekhar inaugurated the pre-production run of India's first lithium cell manufacturing facility at Tirupati, Andhra Pradesh. This state-of-the-art facility has been set up by Chennai-based Munoth Industries Limited with an outlay of Rs 165 Cr. The installed capacity of the plant at present is 270 Mwh and can produce 20,000 cells of 10Ah capacity daily. Currently India imports complete requirements of lithium-ion cells primarily from China, South Korea, Vietnam and Hong Kong. {Read more}

417. H.E. Ms. Catherine Colonna, Minister for Europe and Foreign Affairs of France, was on an official visit to India from 13-15 September, 2022. The Ministers welcomed the expansion of bilateral relations to new areas like the Blue Economy and Ocean Governance. As part of the roadmap on Blue Economy, India will be the 'Country of Honour' at the "Sea Tech Week" in Brest, France. Both Ministers welcomed the launch of India's Unified Payment Interface (UPI) in France, a result of the signature of an MoU between the NPCI and Lyra Networks of France. On defence industry cooperation, the Ministers welcomed Safran Group's decision to set up their largest and first aircraft engine MRO (maintenance, repair, and overhaul) facility in Hyderabad. The facility will be set up with an investment of Rs 1,200 crore (\$150 million) and is expected to create about 1,000 high-skilled jobs in Telangana. Moreover, India and France agreed to set up "Indo-Pacific Trilateral Framework" and "Indo-Pacific Trilateral Development Cooperation Fund". {Read more}

418. On September 17, Poland opened new sea waterway to cut dependence on Russia. The canal, built at a cost of almost 2 billion zlotys (\$420 million), cuts across the Vistula Spit, east of Gdansk, and is designed to allow ships to sail from the Baltic Sea and the Bay of Gdansk to ports of the Vistula lagoon without having to travel through Russia's Strait of Pilawa. {Read more}

419. On September 21, WHO announced that Malawi has become the first country in southern Africa to eliminate trachoma. This makes Malawi the fourth country in WHO's Africa region to achieve this milestone after Ghana (June 2018), Gambia (April 2021) and Togo (May 2022). Trachoma is the world's leading infectious cause of blindness and is one of the conditions known as neglected tropical diseases. As of March 7, 2022, 14 countries had reported achieving trachoma elimination goals. These countries are Cambodia, China, Gambia, Ghana, Iran, Iraq, Lao People's Democratic Republic, Mexico, Morocco, Myanmar, Nepal, Oman, Saudi Arabia and Togo. {Read more}

**420.** On September 16, the Members of the European Parliament (MEP) declared that Hungary is no longer a 'full democracy'. MEPs voted 433 in favour, 123 against, to now describe Hungary a 'hybrid regime of electoral autocracy' in serious breach of EU democratic norms. Hungary is ruled by populist Prime Minister Viktor Orban, who maintains close ties to Russian President Vladimir Putin. {Read more}

The registry was developed by Carbon Tracker, a non-profit think tank, and Global Energy Monitor, an organization that tracks a variety of energy projects around the globe. {Read more}

# **Schemes & Initiatives**

434. In order to reduce the use of chemical fertilisers by incentivising states, the Union government plans to introduce a new scheme namely "PM PRANAM" Scheme (PM Promotion of Alternate Nutrients for Agriculture Management Yojana). The proposed scheme intends to reduce the subsidy burden on chemical fertilisers, which is expected to increase to Rs 2.25 lakh Crore in 2022-2023. 50% subsidy savings will be passed on as a grant to the state that saves the money, and that 70% of the grant provided under the scheme can be used for asset creation related to technological adoption of alternate fertilisers. The total requirement of four fertilisers - Urea, DAP (Di-ammonium Phosphate), MOP (Muriate of potash), NPKS (Nitrogen, Phosphorus and Potassium), increased by 21% between 2017-2018 and 2021-2022, from 528.86 lakh metric tonnes (LMT) to 640.27 LMT. {Read more}
