What: approves acquisition of 7. 73% equity share capital of Jio Platforms Limited by Google International LLC

When: published on 12th November 2020

The Competition Commission of India (CCI) approves acquisition of 7. 73% equity share capital of Jio Platforms Limited (JPL) by Google International LLC (GIL) under Section 31(1) of the Competition Act, 2002.

GIL is a wholly owned subsidiary of Google LLC(collectively with all Google LLC subsidiaries, Google). Google LLC is a Delaware limited liability company and wholly owned subsidiary of Alphabet Inc. GIL is a holding company and does not own / operate any of Google's products/ services.

JPL is a subsidiary of Reliance Industries Limited, which holds the majority of its issued equity share capital. JPL along with its subsidiaries primarily offers / will offer digital products / services, including wireless, home broadband and enterprise broadband services, telecommunication services, mobile applications, various digital platforms, back-end technology services for ecommerce entities and other miscellaneous software and technology related services.

Indian Navy's fifth Scorpene class submarine 'Vagir' was launched on Thursday at Mumbai's Mazagon Dock.

According to an official statement, Union minister of state for defence, Shripad Naik launched the fifth Scorpene class submarine 'Vagir' of Project 75 in Arabian sea waters at Mazagon Dock, in Mumbai through video conferencing today.



Vagir is part of the six Kalvari-class submarines being built in India. The submarines, designed by French naval defence and energy company DCNS, are being built as part of Indian Navy's Project-75. (Read more)

Chen's victory at the bio-secure Weihai Nanhai Olympic Center made her the first winner of the ITTF's #RESTART series and also took her tally of senior singles titles to 19.

What: asks digital media to comply with 26% FDI within a month

When: published on 16th November 2020

The Union Ministry of Information and Broadcasting has issued a public notice, asking news aggregators and agencies that supply news and current affairs to websites, to comply with an earlier order in which the Centre had capped foreign direct investment (FDI) at 26 per cent.

The notification asks "eligible entities involved in uploading/streaming of news and current affairs through digital media, to comply with the decision of the Union Government on 18th September 2019, which had permitted 26% FDI under government approval route."

The ministry has asked eligible agencies to comply with the order within a month.

Announcing the FDI quota in an earlier order issued in October, the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade had asked entities uploading or streaming digital news and current affairs to comply within a year from the date of issue of the clarification. (Read more)

has a gender-specific focus on reserving physical and social infrastructure for the ladies and it also provides approximately 90 land reservations to address women's needs including education, health, housing and safety. This game-changing plan has an entire chapter titled 'Gender, Special Groups and Social Equity', added by the BMC under the Revised Draft Development Plan 2034. (Read more)

What: Urges Increasing Spending On Health Sector To 2. 5% Of GDP By 2024

When: published on 18th November 2020

NK Singh, Chairman of the 15th Finance Commission, on Wednesday suggested increasing public spending on the health sector to 2.5% of the GDP in four years from 0.95% at present.

Flagging skewed nature of health infrastructure, Singh said it is "unfortunate" that the poorest part of the country has worst infrastructure.

"So, how does one address the skewed nature of availability of health infrastructure among different states in India, particularly those which are most vulnerable?," Singh remarked while speaking at the Asia Health 2020 event organised by industry body CII.

He also said that both centre and states need to improve their public outlay on health significantly. (Read more)

Who: Delhi Airport

What: becomes 1st airport in Asia Pacific Region to achieve Level 4+ Accreditation under ACI's Airport Carbon Accreditation

When: published on 20th November 2020

GMR led Delhi International Airport Limited today announced that it has become Asia Pacific's first Level 4+ (Transition) accredited airport under ACI's Airport Carbon Accreditation program. The announcement was made by ACI on 17th November during the ACI EUROPE Annual Assembly & Congress.

Airport Carbon Accreditation is the global standard for carbon management in the airport industry. It aims to encourage and enable airports and its stakeholders to implement best practices in Greenhouse Gas (GHG) management and achieve emission reductions.

The Airport Carbon Accreditation programme of ACI was launched in 2009. Initially had 4 Levels- "Level 1: Mapping", "Level 2: Reduction", "Level 3: Optimisation" and "Level 3+ Neutrality". Delhi Airport reached "Level 3+, Neutrality" in 2016, as the first Carbon Neutral Airport in Asia Pacific region. This



was the highest level of accreditation at that time and DIAL has maintained "Level 3+, Neutrality" accreditation since then. (Read more)

Who: Over 100 scientists

What: join hands with the United Nations to tackle misinformation on Covid-19 vaccines

When: published on 17th November 2020

The United Nations has collaborated with The Vaccine Confidence Project at the University of London's School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine to undertake Team Halo, an initiative which aims to counter the misinformation around Covid-19 vaccines.

Through this initiative, over 100 scientists have joined hands to tackle the issue of misinformation around Covid-19 vaccines and build confidence by busting myths and sharing information on the safety and effectiveness of vaccines on social media.

"At my institution we are studying how Covid-19 reinfection operates and I am excited about opening up the story of the search for Covid-19 vaccines for the public. People want to know about the science and stories behind the headlines, and I'm delighted to be experimenting with social media to make serious points in creative ways," said Dr Gagandeep Kang, Chair of the Immunization Technical Advisory Group for the World Health Organisation South East Asian Region and a Team Halo contributor who works on vaccine development, clinical and laboratory evaluation of vaccines and vaccination policy. What: presented the report "Stop the virus of disinformation: the malicious use of social media by terrorist, violent extremist and criminal groups during the COVID-19 Pandemic"

Groups associated with al-Qaeda and ISIS are exploiting the COVID-19 pandemic to spread conspiracy theories that the virus is "punishing the unbelievers", is "God"s wrath upon the West" and incites terrorists to use it as a form of biological weapon, according to a UN report.

The report titled "Stop the virus of disinformation: the malicious use of social media by terrorist, violent extremist and criminal groups during the COVID-19 pandemic" was released by the United Nations Interregional Crime and Justice Research Institute (UNICRI) on Wednesday.

It said that criminals and violent extremists are exploiting the pandemic to build their support networks, undermine trust in government and even weaponise the virus. The report added that



terrorist, violent extremist and organised criminal groups have maliciously used social media to disseminate conspiracy theories about the origin of COVID-19. (Read more)

What: inaugurates capacity building component of the PM-FME Scheme

When: published on 18th November 2020

Union Minister for Food Processing Industries Shri Narendra Singh Tomar in the presence of Shri Rameswar Teli, MoS, FPI virtually inaugurated the capacity building component of the Pradhan Mantri Formalisation of Micro food processing Enterprises scheme (PM-FME Scheme) and launched the GIS One District One Product (ODOP) digital map of India.

Speaking on the occasion, Shri Tomar said, "Our Honorable Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi ji's resolve is to make India self-reliant. What: sworn in, calls for calm after protests

Peruvian lawmaker Francisco Sagasti was sworn in as interim president on Tuesday, voted for by Congress in an effort to return stability to a country that has seen deadly protests and the departure of two presidents over the last week.

Sagasti, a legislator from the centrist Purple Party, is expected to serve out his term until July next year, with a new presidential election scheduled for April 11.

The Andean nation has been shaken since the abrupt ouster in an impeachment trial of popular leader Martin Vizcarra on November 9. The removal of Vizcarra, whose anti-graft agenda had caused tensions with Congress, triggered often violent protests in which two young people died.

Vizcarra's successor, Manuel Merino, resigned on Sunday after just five days in power. (Read more)

Dr. Harsh Vardhan, Union Minister for Health and Family Welfare digitally addressed the Ministerial meeting of the Global Prevention Coalition (GPC) for HIV Prevention, here today through Video Conference.

Hosted by UNAIDS and UNFPA on behalf of the Global HIV Prevention Coalition (GPC), the conference this year holds significance in achieving the 2016 UNGA commitment to end AIDS by 2030. Member States of GPC had agreed to reduce new adult HIV infections by 75% at the end of 2020 from 2010 levels.

Acknowledging that Global AIDS response has shown remarkable success in reducing new infections, improving access to prevention services for key population and treatment services for People living with HIV (PLHIV), reducing AIDS related mortality, enabling reduction in mother to child transmission of HIV and creating an enabling environment, Dr. Harsh Vardhan noted that the organization "has shown to the world a model where multiple stakeholders can come together and work cohesively towards a common goal." What: gets ninth Poseidon 8I maritime reconnaissance aircraft from the US

When: published on 19th November 2020

The Indian Navy on Wednesday received the first of the four Poseidon 8I maritime reconnaissance and anti-submarine warfare aircraft from the US under a USD 1. 1 billion deal, official sources said. The aircraft, equipped with the latest sensors, landed at INS Hansa, a key naval base in Goa, in the morning, they said.

The Indian Navy already has a fleet of eight P-8I aircraft which are extensively deployed to keep track of movement of Chinese ships and submarines in the Indian Ocean Region.

The P-8I, based on the Boeing next-generation 737 commercial airplane, is a variant of the P-8A Poseidon used by the US Navy. (Read more)
