


**Who:** World Day of Remembrance for Road Traffic Victims 2021

Hamilton claimed his seventh season win and 102nd overall ahead of Verstappen at the flood-lit Losail International Circuit where his Mercedes had already been superior over Verstappen's Red Bull in qualifying.

The Socialist-aligned Radev, who has campaigned on an anti-corruption message, won about 66.7 percent support, trailed by Anastas Gerdzhikov backed by former Prime Minister Boyko Borissov's GERB party, at 31.9 percent, according to official figures with 99.8 percent of ballots counted.

Radev was a major supporter of anti-corruption protests launched last year against Borissov, who was ultimately forced out of power this past spring amid a rule-of-law crisis after dominating the country's politics for more than a decade.

J&K Mission Director of NHM Yasin Choudhary spoke on various aspects of Ayushman Bharat Digital Health Mission (ABDM) including HMIS, e-Sanjeevani- Telemedicine, RBSK and ASHA applications. While giving details about the project, Mr. Choudhary said that Swasthya Nidhi, a Survey App is an integrated health audit and intensive screening framework designed to collect the health data of individuals from households in J&K and to take timely action to track suspicious COVID-19 patients. The data after collection is scanned by medical teams to take requisite action for preventing the spread of the virus. It is a unique initiative of the Government which helped to contain the spread of COVID-19. Under this initiative, various teams were constituted to perform the health audit of the citizens. The teams captured health status of the people which helped to identify the symptomatic people and necessary containment measures were taken by the department.

The Central Board of Trustees (CBT) of the Employees' Provident Fund Organisation (EPFO) have approved that up to 5 percent of the annual deposits can be invested in alternative investment funds (AIFs) including infrastructure investment trusts (InvITs).

This investment will offer diversification to the EPFO's investment basket.

The Finance Investment and Audit Committee (FIAC) have been tasked to decide upon the investment options, on case-to-case basis.

However, the board has also decided to focus only on government-backed alternatives, which are category one funds like public sector InvITs and bonds.

The AIFs are regulated by the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI).

President Nayib Bukele said El Salvador plans to build the world's first "Bitcoin City", powered by a volcano and financed by cryptocurrency bonds. Bitcoin City "is gonna include everything: residential areas, commercial areas, services, museums, entertainment... airport, port, rail," Bukele said at the Latin American Bitcoin and Blockchain Conference on Saturday. El Salvador, which has used the US dollar for two decades, was the first country in the world to legalize bitcoin as legal tender. Bukele said the Conchagua volcano "will power the whole city and will also power the mining." Bitcoin mining is the process by which new bitcoin is created using computers that solve complex mathematical problems — a process which demands huge amounts of energy.

In El Salvador, some of that energy comes from a geothermal plant fed by the Tecapa volcano. Bukele said the city would initially be powered by the Tecapa plant before his government builds a new geothermal plant powered by Conchagua.

A former military commander, Chun oversaw the 1980 Gwangju massacre of pro-democracy demonstrators, a crime for which he was later convicted and received a commuted death sentence.

A Long March 4B lifted off from the Taiyuan Satellite Launch Center in northern China at 8:51 p. m. Friday, inserting the Gaofen-11 (03) satellite into a 247 by 694-kilometer altitude orbit inclined by 97. 5 degrees.

The China Aerospace Science and Technology Corp. (CASC) announced launch success shortly after orbital insertion. However details about the satellite's capabilities were not revealed.

State media Xinhua stated the satellite would be "mainly used for land surveys, city planning, land rights confirmation, road network design, crop yield estimation and disaster prevention and mitigation."
