The Competition Commission of India (CCI) has approved acquisition of 100% shareholding in Exide

Life Insurance Company Limited by HDFC Life Insurance Company under Section 31(1) of the

Competition Act, 2002.



The Proposed Combination involves acquisition of fully paid-up equity shares, representing 100% of Target by the Acquirer from Exide Industries Limited. After completion of the share acquisition, Exide Life (which will be a wholly owned subsidiary of HDFC Life) is proposed to be merged with HDFC Life.

The Acquirer is a life insurance company registered with the Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India (the IRDAI). It offers a range of individual and group life insurance solutions including participating, non-participating and unit linked insurance products. Its product portfolio comprises of various life insurance and investment products such as protection, pension, savings, investment, and annuity.

The partnership is aligned with the DAY-NRLM's goal of strengthening the capabilities of rural communities for self-employment and entrepreneurship, thus providing further impetus to the Prime Minister's vision of an "Atmanirbhar Bharat".

The Ministry of Defence (MoD) has given clearance for Indian made acquisition proposals worth Rs 7,965 crore aimed at modernisation of armed forces.

The decision was taken at the Defence Acquisition Council (DAC), a meeting chaired by Defence Minister Rajnath Singh on November 2.

"Key approvals of procurement from domestic sources include twelve light utility helicopters from Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL); Lynx U2 Fire Control System from Bharat Electronics Limited



(BEL) which will enhance the detection tracking and engagement capabilities of Naval warships and Mid-Life Upgradation of the Dornier Aircraft from HAL to increase the Naval capacity of maritime reconnaissance and coastal surveillance," a statement from the Ministry Of Defence said.

As a further impetus to 'Aatmanirbhar Bharat', a global procurement case of Naval guns has been foreclosed with these guns' added to the upgraded 'Super Rapid Gun Mount' (SRGM) being manufactured by Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited (BHEL).

The Union Home Minister Amit Shah launched the 'Ayushman Bharat CAPF' healthcare scheme for the personnel of Central Armed Police Forces (CAPFs) on a pan-India basis. The scheme will be rolled out across all states and Union Territories (UTs) in a phased manner from November 2 onwards.

While inaugurating the Ayushman Bharat scheme for armed soldiers, he handed over a representative card to a Jawan of CAPF and also handed a bunch of cards to the DG, National Security Guard (NSG) to hand over some health cards to the NSG personnel on the occasion of the 'Dhanvantari Pooja'. 'Dhanvantri Pooja' is celebrated in honour of 'The God of Medicine'.
