Who: Union Minister Dr Jitendra Singh

What: Inaugurated 650 Teraflops Supercomputing Facility at NABI & i-RISE, TBI at Mohali

When: published on 2<sup>nd</sup> November 2021

While inaugurating advanced 650 teraflops supercomputing facility at National Agri-Food Biotechnology Institute (NABI) at Mohali today, Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) Science & Technology; Minister of State (Independent Charge) Earth Sciences; MoS PMO, Personnel, Public Grievances, Pensions, Atomic Energy and Space, Dr Jitendra Singh announced that the Government will identify and promote 75 innovative Start-Ups in the 75th year of India's independence and this new supercomputing facility will act as a facilitator for these Start-ups working in areas like Telemedicine, Digital Health, mHealth with BIG Data, AI, BlockChain and other technologies.

The Minister further said that the 75 Best Chosen Start-ups will be an asset for India to lead the country in the next 25 years, during the celebrations of Centenary of India's Independence.

About NABI, Dr Jitendra Singh said, the facility has come up under the National Supercomputing Mission (NSM) in collaboration with C-DAC, Pune. The Minister said that this high-end facility will be a boon for the analysis of BIG DATA accruing from the large-scale genomics, functional genomics, structural genomics and population studies being carried out at various Institutes and universities of national and international repute.

According to a State government news release, an MoU between TIIC, CII, and SIDM was signed on November 1 in the presence of the Minister for Industries Thangam Thennarasu.

The Tamilnadu Defence Corridor, which has five nodes in Chennai, Tiruchirappalli, Coimbatore, Salem, and Hosur, provides a chance for MSMEs in Tamil Nadu to thrive in the Defense Manufacturing ecosystem while also providing job opportunities for the state's young. The Chief Minister's vision of making Tamil Nadu's economy a \$1 trillion economy by 2030 would rely heavily on defence manufacturing.

HDFC Bank will identify potential startups as well as SMEs and help them to partner with intermediaries like merchant bankers, chartered accountants and lawyers to list on BSE.



Both the parties have agreed to conduct and participate in joint outreach activities and contribute to each other's publications on the startup ecosystem in India.

Air forces of India and Egypt conducted a two-day exercise at the latter's El Berigat airbase to enhance mutual understanding and share operational experience, an official statement said on Tuesday. The exercise, called 'Desert Warrior', was conducted on October 30 and October 31, the Indian Air Force (IAF) said on Twitter.

In December 2019, then Air Chief Marshal RKS Bhadauria had visited Egypt and met Air Marshal Mohamed Abbas Helmy, the Commander-in-Chief of Egypt Air Force, to boost cooperation between the two services.

"The IAF and Egyptian Air Force participated in Exercise Desert Warrior conducted at El Berigat Air Base, Egypt from 30-31 Oct 2021. It enhanced mutual understanding and provided an opportunity to share valuable operational experience," the IAF noted on Twitter.

What: launches world's first Earth-science satellite dedicated to UN 2030 Agenda

China successfully launched a Guangmu Earth-science satellite via a Long March-6 carrier rocket from Taiyuan Satellite Launch Center. Guangmu is the world's first Earth-science satellite dedicated to serving the United Nations 2030 Sustainable Development Agenda upon the 50th anniversary of the restoration of the lawful rights of the People's Republic of China in the UN.

Developed by the Chinese Academy of Sciences, the satellite will carry out precision analysis of energy consumption, habitat patterns and coastal areas in the vicinity of human populations, and provide data for sustainable development indicators.

What: Declares Public Holiday on November 10 for Chhath Puja

The Delhi government declared a public holiday on November 10 on account of Chhath Puja. The Delhi Disaster Management Authority had last week issued an order allowing the celebration of Chhath Puja at designated sites in the city except on the banks of the Yamuna river.

"Chhath Puja is an important festival for the people of NCT of Delhi. Accordingly, the Government of Delhi has decided to declare November 10, 2021, as a public holiday on account of Chhath Puja," said a note issued by Deputy Chief Minister Manish Sisodia. The DDMA had issued on September 30 prohibiting the celebration of Chhath at public places due to the threat of COVID-19.

Chhath, celebrate<mark>d after Di</mark>wali by people belonging to Bihar and eastern Uttar Pradesh, involves the offering of 'Arghya' by fasting women to the Sun god in knee-deep water. It involves elaborate rituals spanning over three days.
