Who: FM Nirmala Sitharaman

What: announced LTC cash voucher scheme

When: published on 13th October 2020

Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman, on October 12, announced a Leave Travel Concession (LTC) cash voucher scheme to increase consumer spending.

Under this LTC Cash Voucher Scheme, government employees can opt to receive cash amounting to leave encashment, plus three times ticket fare, to buy items which attract a GST of 12 percent or more. Only digital transactions allowed, GST invoice to be produced, FM Nirmala Sitharaman said.(Read more)

Who: Arunachal Pradesh

What: to feature on country's aviation map with Greenfield airport at Hollongi

When: published on 12th October 2020

Arunachal Pradesh is poised to feature on country's aviation map with a greenfield airport at Hollongi, 15 kilometres from Itanagar. With estimated cost of 650 crore rupees, the project includes the development work, construction of airport pavements, air side work, terminal Building and city side works.

The new domestic airport, with an area of 4,100 square metres, the Hollongi Airport will be able to handle 200 passengers during peak hours. Equipped with eight check-in counters, the terminal building will have all modern passenger facilities.(Read more)

Who: FM Nirmala Sitharaman

What: announces fiscally prudent proposals to tune of Rs 73,000 cr to boost demand

Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman announced major schemes to boost demands in the country by nearly 73 thousand crore rupees. Addressing a media briefing in the National Capital today, the minister laid out the details of the fiscally prudent proposals to stimulate demand in the economy. Ms. Sitharaman informed that the new proposals aim at giving a thrust of around 36 thousand crore rupees to the consumer demands by the Leave Travel Concession LTC Voucher and Festival advance scheme. Additionally she said, 37 thousand crore rupees will be infused in the capital expenditure by the Centre and the State Governments.

Briefing about the schemes, the minister informed that in lieu of the LTC for the 2018-21 block term, payments will be made to the government employees for their 10 day Leave encashment and eligible travel fare. She informed, the employees opting for the scheme will have to submit GST invoices for purchase of goods or services amounting to three times the value of travel fare in addition to the value of LTC encashment amount. What: to launch Mission Shakti for women in Navratri

The Yogi Adityanath government will dedicate the upcoming Navratri festival to women's safety, dignity and empowerment by launching 'Mission Shakti' on October 17.

The initiative will begin in 'Shardiya Navratri' and will continue for the next six months till the 'Chaitra Navratri' in April.

The government spokesman said in a statement that various programmes will be organised from the Gram Panchayats to industrial units, school campuses to government offices, from the Durga Puja pandals to Ramlilas to reaffirm the faith and resolve towards the women power. (Read more)

What: gets a second term as FMSCI president

Former racer Akbar Ebrahim was on Monday unanimously elected for a second term as the president of India's motorsports governing body, Federation of Motor Sports Clubs of India (FMSCI).

The elections were held via video-conference amid the COVID-19 pandemic. Ebrahim had his first stint as FMSCI chief from 2016-2018 following which he was replaced by J Prithviraj.



"It is without doubt, going to be a very challenging and tough year given the unprecedented pandemic situation the whole world is facing. I am sure that the FMSCI will collectively rise to the occasion and manage the situation to the best of its ability," Ebrahim said in a statement. (Read more)

"This year's Laureates, Paul Milgrom and Robert Wilson, have studied how auctions work. They have also used their insights to design new auction formats for goods and services that are difficult to sell in a traditional way, such as radio frequencies," The Royal Swedish Academy of Sciences said in a press release.(Read more)

What: unveils massive new ballistic missile in military parade

When: published on 10th October 2020



North Korea unveiled what analysts believe to be one of the world's largest ballistic missiles at a military parade celebrating the 75th anniversary of the Workers' Party broadcast on state-run television on Saturday.

The massive weapon was carried by an 11-axle truck at the climax of the almost two-hour ceremony and military parade in the capital of Pyongyang.

Analysts said the new missile is not known to have been tested, but a bigger weapon would allow North Korea to put multiple warheads on it, increasing the threat it would pose to any targeted foe.(Read more)

Who: Olympic champion Charlie Moore

What: dies at 91

Charlie Moore, the 400m hurdles champion at the 1952 Helsinki Olympics, has died.

He was 91.

Moore died on Thursday from pancreatic cancer, according to World Athletics. Cornell University also confirmed the passing of the school's former athletic director and star athlete.

Moore won the 400m hurdles in the rain in 1952 in 50.8 seconds to tie the Olympic record he set in the quarterfinals. Moore also earned a silver medal in Helsinki on the United States' 1,600m relay team.(Read more)

What: to provide high-speed satellite connectivity to 5,000 remote gram panchayats

Hughes India said that it has been selected by Bharat Broadband Nigam Limited (BBNL) and Telecommunications Consultants India Ltd.(TCIL) to provide high-speed satellite connectivity to 5,000 remote gram panchayats.

Hughes India will enable Internet service for each gram panchayat using capacity from ISRO's GSAT-19 and GSAT-11 satellites with the Hughes JUPITER System, the de facto standard for satellite broadband implementations, in use on more than 40 satellites worldwide.

The awards are part of the government's flagship BharatNet Programme to provide broadband connectivity to all 250,000 gram panchayats throughout India.

What: launches ACE Credit Card in collaboration with Google Pay and Visa

When: published on 12th October 2020

Axis Bank, in collaboration with Google Pay and Visa, has launched the ACE Credit Card. Payments for mobile recharges, bill payments made via Google Pay earn users 5% in cashback. Users also get 4%-5% cashback for spends made on daily use categories such as food ordering, online grocery delivery, cab rides for transactions made on partner merchant platforms such as Swiggy, Zomato, BigBasket, Grofers and Ola. There is also an unlimited 2% cashback on all other transactions.

Users will be able to get cashback directly into their ACE Credit Card accounts. The tokenisation feature enabled in partnership with Visa, will allow Google Pay users to use their ACE Credit Card to make payments through a secure digital token attached to their phone without having to physically share their card details.(Read more)

What: extends USD 400 million soft loan to Maldives for financing connectivity project

When: published on 12th October 2020

India has extended a USD 400 million (about Rs 2,932 crore) soft loan to Maldives through the Exim Bank to finance a connectivity project in the nation of islands, a statement said on Monday. The Export-Import Bank of India (Exim Bank) on behalf of the Government of India has extended a Line of Credit (LoC) of USD 400 million for undertaking Greater Male's connectivity project in Maldives, the bank said.

The loan agreement was inked in Male on Monday between Exim Bank General Manager Nirmit Ved and Maldives' Finance Minister Ibrahim Ameer. With the signing of the above agreement, Exim Bank has till date extended three LoCs worth a cumulative USD 1.2 billion to Maldives, on behalf of India.(Read more)

Who: India, Japan & Five Eyes Alliance

What: demand access to end-to-end encrypted chats from tech companies

When: published on 12th October 2020

India on Sunday joined the Five Eyes alliance and Japan governments in asking big tech companies to come up with a solution for law enforcement to access end-to-end encrypted communications. The seven governments demanded backdoors into end-to-end encrypted chats as end-to-end encryption prevents authorities from looking into serious crimes and matters like national security.

The Five Eyes intelligence alliance companies consist of the US, the UK, Canada, Australia, and New Zealand and have made similar calls to tech giants in 2018 and 2019.

The representatives from the seven governments asserted the need for encryption backdoors not just for encrypted instant messaging applications, but also for device encryption, custom encrypted applications, and encryption across integrated platforms. (Read more)
