Who: A New Species of Onion: Allium Negianum

What: was discovered in Uttarakhand

When: published on 19<sup>th</sup> October 2021

A plant discovered in Uttarakhand in 2019 has been newly confirmed as a new species of Allium — the genus that includes many staple foods such as onion and garlic, among 1,100 species worldwide. The new species is described in journal PhytoKeys.

In 2019, Dr Anjula Pandey, Principal Scientist at ICAR-National Bureau of Plant Genetic Resources in New Delhi, together with scientists Drs K Madhav Rai, Pavan Kumar Malav and S Rajkumar, came across plants of this onion species, which they have named Allium negianum, in the border area of Malari village, in Chamoli district of Uttarakhand. It grows at 3,000 to 4,800 m above sea level and can be found along open grassy meadows, sandy soils along rivers, and streams forming in snow pasture lands along alpine meadows, where the melting snow helps carry its seeds to more favourable areas. With a narrow distribution, this newly described species is restricted to the region of western Himalayas and hasn't yet been reported from anywhere else in the world, according to a blog post from Pensoft Publishers, which brings out the journal.

Pakistan (with 52.6 points) scored better than India (50.2 points) in the category of food affordability. Sri Lanka was even better with 62.9 points in this category on the GFS Index 2021, a global report released by Economist Impact and Corteva Agriscience on Tuesday said.

Tamil Nadu FibreNet Corporation Ltd (TANFINET) signed the Master Service Agreement for the implementation of BharatNet Project in Tamil Nadu (two packages) with various system integrators. The project aims at providing 1 Gbps bandwidth connectivity to all Gram Panchayats. It signed the agreement with L&T (for Package C); ITI Ltd (Package D) and Third-Party Agency BECIL in the

presence of Information Technology minister T Mano Thangaraj and IT Secretary Neeraj Mittal.

Later talking to newspersons, the minister said that there was a delay in starting the BharatNet Project as the tender issued in the previous AIADMK government was cancelled and a new tender was issued. After the disposal of the pending litigations in Package A and Package B, the project will

be implemented in all the 12,525 Gram Panchayats in Tamil Nadu, he said.

The project will cover Gram Panchayats through optical fibre cable with high-speed bandwidth connectivity. TANFINET is a special purpose vehicle implementing the BharatNet project in Tamil Nadu at a total cost of ₹1,815 crore.

The Reserve Bank has imposed a penalty of ₹1 crore on Paytm Payments Bank Limited (PPBL) and ₹27.78 lakh on Western Union Financial Services for non-compliance with certain directions.

In a release, the RBI said on examination of PPBL's application for issue of final Certificate of Authorisation (CoA), it was observed that it had submitted information which did not reflect the factual position.

"As this was an offence of the nature referred to in Section 26 (2) of the Payment and Settlement Systems Act, 2007, a notice was issued to PPBL.

State-owned Bank of Maharashtra reported a 103 % jump in its standalone net profit to ₹ 264 crore in the September 2021 quarter, helped by healthy growth in net interest income.

The lender had reported a standalone profit after tax of ₹ 130 crore in the same quarter of the previous fiscal.



The bank's performance in the July-September 2021 period was good despite the pandemic, the bank's Managing Director and CEO A.S. Rajeev said.

"One major reason for higher profit is growth of 34 % in NII (net interest income). Our core performance has improved," he told reporters.

When: published on 21st October 2021

In a major announcement, Kremlin on Wednesday stated that Russian President Vladimir Putin will not attend the COP26 Climate Change Summit in Glasgow in person. However, as per media reports, he could take part in the summit via video conference. The declaration comes a day after the UK stressed that all national leaders must attend the summit.

As per SkyNews, the Kremlin had earlier announced President Putin's absence from the G20 Summit in Rome over COVID-19 pandemic concerns. "We will also not fly to Glasgow, unfortunately," President's spokesperson Dmitry Peskov said in a statement and added that the Kremlin will "work out" on the format for Putin to "speak via videoconference". While President Putin had earlier stated that he will attend the Summit but has not yet commented on the current announcement.

Although on 13 October, while speaking at an international energy forum in Moscow President Putin indicated that the surging COVID-19 cases in the country could be a reason for his change in travel plans. It is to mention that on 20 October the country recorded approximately 34,000 fresh coronavirus infections and 1,028 fatalities in a single day, The Moscow Times reported, citing the Russian health bulletin.

Meanwhile, Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan informed that the state government has decided to give subsidies of more than 20 thousand crore rupees in electricity to domestic and agricultural consumers for the financial year 2021-22.



As per the decision taken by the state cabinet, the government will give a subsidy of Rs 4 thousand 981 crore for the domestic consumers under the Griha Jyoti Yojana. At the same time, a subsidy of more than Rs 15 thousand 722 crore will be given for the consumers of the agriculture sector.

Shah said Manipur played a significant role in resisting the British in the Northeast during the 1857 revolution and in 1891. Manipur never gave up and the people there continued to fight. The state was the only one to implement its own constitution. Manipur war hero Yubraj Tikendrajit and General Thangal were publicly hanged in Fida, Imphal. The British thought that by hanging them, they had crushed the freedom movement but it did not happen. After that, Maharaja Kulachandra Dhwaja Singh and 22 freedom fighters were sent to Kalapani and kept on Mount Harriet. Today, in his memory, we would like to honour his contribution by renaming Mount Harriet Mount Manipur.

Achim Steiner, the U.N. Development Programme's (UNDP) administrator said Germany, a first contributor, had pledged 50 million euros (\$58 million) to the fund, and that it was in touch with other donors to mobilise resources.
