Who: Former IAS officer and author of Chola History books

What: passes away

When: published on 21st October 2020

Former IAS officer B. Venkataraman who was an authority on Chola History and Architecture expired in a private hospital in Delhi on Tuesday afternoon. He was 95.

Mr. Venkataraman, a 1950 batch officer, had served as chief secretary Orissa and then as secretary, Ministry of Tourism and Civil Aviation, New Delhi. Besides his career as an IAS officer, he had a passion for Chola art and history that he had inherited from his father S.R. Balasubrahmanyam. He had coauthored a book 'Later Chola Temples' with his father.

Some of the books that he had authored include 'Laddigam: A Later Chola Temples', 'Temple Art under the Chola queens' and 'Rajarajeswaram-the pinnacle of Chola art' on the Thanjavur Brihadeeshwara temple. His doctoral thesis was on the contribution of the Chola queen Sembiyan Mahadevi.(Read more)

Ministry of Union Housing and Urban Affairs has recently launched the 'e-Dharti Geo Portal' which will integrate legacy drawings such as maps and lease plans in the management information system. It will allow the data to become geographic information system (GIS)-enabled.

BusinesLine quoted Hardeep Singh Puri, Union Housing and Urban Affairs Minister as saying that the land & development office (L&DO) is dealing with around 60,000 properties that are commercial, residential, industrial as well as institutional.

The ministry issued in a statement that the L&DO has developed a property certificate incorporating details and the outline map of the property which is available online on the portal.

The statement added that the power of technology is immense and there is no reason that India, which has a formidable capacity in the area of software technologies, cannot or shouldn't harness this strength to their advantage.(Read more)

What: has become the first city in the country to have longest BRTS corridor in country

A new landmark has been added in the urban transport sector in Surat. Thanks to the efforts of Surat Municipal Corporation, it has become the longest 108 km BRTS corridor in the country. Currently, there are more than 166 buses operating on a total of 13 routes in the BRTS corridor of 102 km. In which more than 1.03 lakh passengers travel daily. In which Chief Minister Vijay Rupani e-launched the route from Kumbharia to Kadodra (06 km length).

Public transport was not available in Surat city in the year 2007. Surat Municipal Corporation took the initiative to start public transport keeping in view the daily transport needs of the public and Surat Citylink Ltd. by Surat Municipal Corporation. A public transport company was formed. BRTS bus service Udha Darwaza-Sachin GIDC on 26/01/2014 by Surat Municipal Corporation. Meanwhile a 12km route was launched.(Read more)

In the coming years, India's aviation sector to get a massive boost! By the year 2024, the Airports Authority of India (AAI) is planning to develop at least 100 airports, waterdromes, and heliports across the country under the regional air connectivity scheme. On Wednesday, the fourth anniversary of the regional air connectivity scheme, also known as UDAN (Ude Desh ka Aam Nagrik), was commemorated. The UDAN scheme of the Modi government is aimed at providing economically viable, affordable, as well as profitable air travel on regional routes. As many as 50 unserved and underserved airports (including five heliports) with 285 routes have been added under the regional air connectivity scheme across the length and breadth of India, according to a PTI report.

To commemorate UDAN Day, Civil Aviation Secretary Pradeep Singh Kharola said stakeholders should work towards making this regional air connectivity scheme sustainable as well as improve its efficiency, during a video conference. The Civil Aviation Secretary also urged airlines to undertake marketing initiatives so that more people can take benefit from the regional air connectivity scheme. According to AAI Chairman Arvind Singh, the authority is committed to developing the infrastructure required for the UDAN scheme across the nation.(Read more)

What: commissioned officer Vijayalakshmi Ramanan passes away at 96

Wing Commander (Retd) Dr Vijayalakshmi Ramanan, the first woman commissioned officer of the Indian Air Force, has died at the age of 96.

Ramanan, a recipient of Vishisht Seva Medal (VSM), died peacefully due to old age ailments on Sunday at her daughter's home here, her son-in-law S L V Narayan said.

Born in February 1924, she did her MBBS and later was commissioned in the Army Medical Corps on August 22, 1955 and was seconded to the Air Force with effect from the same day.



Besides having served as a gynecologist at various Air Force Hospitals, including here, she had also attended to the troops wounded during wars and performed administrative duties.

Ramanan was promoted to the rank of Wing Commander in August 1972, and honoured with the Vishist Seva Medal five years later. She had retired in February, 1979. (Read more)
