Who: Andhra CM Jagan Mohan Reddy along with Union ministers

What: launch door delivery of fertilizers to farmers

When: published on 1st October 2020

Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister YS Jagan Mohan Reddy along with Union ministers launched the door delivery of fertilizers to farmers, PoS version, and SMS gateway from Rythu Bharosa Kendras.

Union Minister for Chemicals and Fertilizers DV Sadananda Gowda and Minister for State Chemicals and Fertilizers Mansukh Mandaviya joined the Chief Minister through video conference from Delhi to launch the facilities.

Speaking on the occasion, Chief Minister YS Jagan Mohan Reddy said that the state government introduced Rythu Bharosa Kendras (RBKs) to assist farmers in every step from the purchase of seed to sale of their produce, which acts as a one-stop destination to address all the needs of farmers across the state. "We have set up about 10,641 RBKs near the Village and ward secretariats and appointed BSC Agriculture graduates as agriculture and horticulture assistants to address the farmers' issues. All the RBKs are equipped with required infrastructure, where farmers can book the seeds and farm needs through digital kiosks and the material will be delivered to them within 48 hours," he said. What: Launches Initiative To Promote Innovation And Entrepreneurship Amongst SC Students

An initiative was launched on Wednesday by the government to promote innovation and entrepreneurship amongst SC students in higher education campuses. The programme named Ambedkar Social Innovation Incubation Mission (ASIIM) was launched by the Minister of Social Justice and Empowerment Thaawarchand Gehlot at an event here.

The ASIIM aims to promote innovation and entrepreneurship among SC students in the higher education campuses, the ministry said in a statement. "There is a need to identify innovative ideas and provide focussed support to young entrepreneurs who are engaged in working on innovative and



technology-oriented business ideas either in educational campuses or Technology Business Incubators (TBIs) to help them set up successful commercial enterprises," it said. In accordance with that the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment said it has decided to launch (ASIIM) through the Venture Capital Fund for Scheduled Castes(VCFSC). Apart from promoting innovation and entrepreneurship amongst SC students, the ministry said the main objectives of ASIIM also include promoting entrepreneurship among the SC Youth with special preference to Divyangs, supporting (1,000) innovative ideas till 2024 through a synergetic work with the Technology Business Incubators (TBIs) set up by Department of Science and Technology among others.(Read more)

What: extends WMA limit relaxations for six months

When: published on 3rd October 2020

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) on Tuesday extended the relaxation in Ways & Means Advances (WMA) limits of states for another six months to enable them to plan their market borrowings to meet revenue mismatches. Earlier in April, the central bank had hiked the borrowing limit of all states and union territories under the WMA facilities by 60 per cent to help them undertake COVID-19 containment and mitigation measures. WMAs are temporary liquidity support provided by the central bank to the government to meet short-term expenditure needs.



"With a view to provide greater comfort to state governments in undertaking COVID-19 containment and mitigation measures, and to enable them to plan their market borrowings, RBI had announced an increase in WMA limit of the States/UTs by 60 per cent over and above the level as on March 31, 2020," the RBI said in a press release.(Read more)

"The ban has been imposed after we received several requests from around the state," a senior official from the Health Department said on Monday. "The government of Maharashtra hereby imposes a complete ban on the sale of single stick loose cigarettes and beedis, being sold without packet as they do not have specific health warning on it in public interest with immediate effect on the State of Maharashtra," an order said on September 24.(Read more)

What: inaugurates 23 Roads and Bridges projects in Kathua, Doda, Udhampur and Reasi Districts

When: published on 30th September 2020



The Union Minister of State (Independent Charge), Development of North Eastern Region (DoNER), MoS PMO, Personnel, Public Grievances, Pensions, Atomic Energy and Space, Dr Jitendra Singh today unveiled 23 roads and bridges projects in Kathua, Doda, Udhampur and Reasi districts in the Jammu region. He said, the projects costing about Rs 73 Crore and having length of 111 kilometers will benefit more than 35,000 people in the region. 23 Projects included 15 roads built under PMGSY for all weather connectivity and 8 bridges for better connectivity to the people.

While e-inaugurating these projects, Dr. Jitendra Singh said that despite serious challenges posed by the Covid19 pandemic in the last few months, barring few all the projects were completed within stipulated timeframe. He emphasised that despite challenges posed by pandemic, the country had not compromised with the pace of development and particularly the UT of Jammu and Kashmir. He was informed that 1150 kilometres of roads built in this fiscal till date in comparison to 800 kilometres last year.(Read more)

The UN General Assembly in a resolution on 15 June 2007, commemorated the birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi as the International Day of Non-violence. The UN said, the objective of the day is to "disseminate the message of non-violence, including through education and public awareness".(Read more)

What: test fires laser-guided anti-tank guided missile

When: published on 1st October 2020

An indigenously developed laser-guided anti-tank guided missile was successfully test fired on Thursday in Maharashtra's Ahmednagar, officials said.

It was the second such successful test firing of the missile, having a range of upto 5 km, in the last 10 days, they said.



The weapon was test fired from an MBT Arjun Tank at KK Ranges in Armoured Corps Centre and School (ACC&S) in Ahmednagar on Tuesday, the officials said.

"The ATGM employs a tandem heat warhead to defeat explosive reactive armour (ERA) protected armoured vehicles in ranges from 1.5 to 5 km," the Defence Ministry said in a statement. (Read more)

What: to launch its first Venus orbiter Shukrayaan-1 in 2025

ISRO is set to launch its first Venus orbiter Shukrayaan-1 in 2025 and France will take part in it, French space agency CNES stated on September 30.

The VIRAL (Venus Infrared Atmospheric Gases Linker) instrument co-developed with the Russian government space agency Roscosmos and the LATMOS atmospheres, environments and space observations lab connected to CNRS has been chosen by the ISRO after a request for proposal, it said in an announcement.

ISRO chief K Sivan and CNES president Jean-Yves Le Gall held talks and audited the regions driving participation among France and India in space. "In the domain of space exploration, France will be taking part in ISRO's mission to Venus, scheduled to launch in 2025. (Read more)

Abu Dhabi-based sovereign wealth fund Mubadala Investment Co will buy a 1.4 per cent stake in Reliance Retail Ventures Ltd (RRVL) for Rs 6,247.5 crore into, the Indian conglomerate announced on Thursday.

Mubadala will be the fourth investor in Reliance Retail Ventures Ltd (RRVL), a subsidiary of Reliance Industries.

"Mubadala Investment Company (Mubadala), the Abu Dhabi-based sovereign investor, will invest Rs 6,247.5 crore (AED 3.1 billion) into Reliance Retail Ventures Limited (RRVL), a subsidiary of India's Reliance Industries Limited (Reliance Industries). The investment values Reliance Retail at a pre-money equity value Rs 4.285 lakh crore. Mubadala's investment will translate into a 1.40 per cent equity stake in RRVL on a fully diluted basis," Reliance Industries said in a regulatory filing. (Read more)

Rajya Sabha MP and Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) leader Sanjay Singh has been chosen for the 'Gandhi Award' instituted by the Mahatma Gandhi National Foundation, its Chairman Eby J Jose said on Friday.

He was instrumental in India's diplomatic intervention to remove Mahatma Gandhi's images on beer bottles of a private company in Israel, Mr Jose, who brought the matter into the public domain, told newspersons this morning.

'Mr Singh also raised the issue in Parliament. Subsequently, India intervened diplomatically to remove Gandhiji's images on beer bottles. It was this move that earned the AAP MP the award," he added.
