Who: South Korea

What: constructed the World's Largest Hydrogen Fuel Cell Power Plant

When: published on 27th October 2021

The Ministry of Trade, Industry and Energy announced on the 26th that it held the completion ceremony of 'Shinincheon Bitdream Fuel Cell Power Plant' at the Shinincheon Bitdream headquarters of Korea Southern Power in Seo-gu, Incheon.

The Shinincheon Bitdream Fuel Cell Power Plant is a power plant with a total capacity of 78 MW constructed in four stages since 2017 by using fuel cells supplied by POSCO Energy and Doosan Fuel Cell. It is the world's largest fuel cell power plant currently in operation.

Unlike other power generators, hydrogen fuel cell emits very little nitrogen oxides (NOX) and sulfur oxides (SOX) as it does not produce electricity through high-temperature combustion.

Switzerland-based reinsurance company Swiss Re will invest ₹920 crore (\$127 million) in Paytm's general insurance business for a 23% stake on a fully diluted basis, the Noida-based financial services company said.

Swiss Re will invest ₹397.3 crore (\$52.9 million) upfront in Paytm Insuretech Pvt. Ltd (PIT) and the remaining in tranches, subject to the fulfilment of certain milestones.

Paytm's Vijay Shekhar Sharma is also expected to make an investment in the entity. The investment is subject to regulatory approvals.

What: approves appointment of Baldev Prakash as J&K Bank MD & CEO

When: published on 28th October 2021

Jammu & Kashmir Bank said the Reserve Bank has approved the appointment of Baldev Prakash as its next Managing Director and CEO from the next year.

The Reserve Bank of India has vide letter dated October 26, 2021 accorded approval to the candidature of Prakash as MD & CEO of the Bank for a period of three years from the date of taking charge or April 10, 2022, whichever is earlier, J&K Bank said in a regulatory filing.

The state-owned lender will separately inform about the appointment of Baldev Prakash as MD & CEO by its board and the actual date of assuming charge by him.

Bibek Debroy, the Chairman of the council, is among the four members who have been retained.

funds-starved infrastructure sector. Parliament had in March cleared the National Bank for Financing Infrastructure and Development (NaBFID) Bill 2021 to support the development of long-term non-recourse infrastructure financing in India, including the development of the bonds and derivatives markets necessary for infrastructure financing.

"New approach to building #AatmaNirbharBharat! Central Government has appointed Shri K. V. Kamath to the post of Chairperson, National Bank for Financing Infrastructure and Development, a newly set up DFI in India," Department of Financial Services (DFS), under the finance ministry, said in a tweet. The DFS, in a notification, said the central government has appointed K V Kamath to the post of chairperson of NaBFID initially for a term of three years from the date of assumption of charge.

According to the statement released on Tuesday, the ROIP system is being introduced as a marine communication mode, for the first time in any major Indian port.

It shall cover the entire Hugli river Estuary from Kolkata to Sandheads, having base stations at four locations, the statement said, adding that with this facility, vessels at Sandheads can be directly communicated via radio, from Kolkata, especially during storms and inclement weather.

Senior Indian Administrative Service (IAS) officer Renu Sharma has been appointed as the new Chief Secretary of Mizoram.

The appointment of Sharma coincided with the Mizoram government appointing state additional chief secretary to the Chief Minister J.C. Ramthanga to take charge as Chief Secretary with effect from November 1.

An official statement said that Sharma is transferred from Delhi and posted as the Chief Secretary of Mizoram with effect from November 1.

Sharma will replace Lalnunmawia Chuaungo, who will leave the chief secretary office on voluntary retirement on October 31.

India's apex food regulator Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) on Wednesday announced the launch of a mobile application to improve connect with consumers and food business operators (FBOs).

The app, Food Safety Connect, will help food businesses, particularly hawkers, vendors and start-ups, to apply for FSSAI registration through a faster and convenient mode, the regulator said in a statement.

The Food Safety and Standards (FSS) Act, 2006 mandates that every food business is required to obtain FSSAI licence or registration prior to commencing the business. India has a large segment of unorganised food businesses that are not much conversant with tech-based platforms.

He was 81 and breathed his last at his home in the city, they said. Nair was known for his various path-breaking initiatives in the field of cancer treatment especially in the areas of community and paediatric oncology and palliative care and his efforts to make expensive treatment affordable to poor people.

He played a key role in the opening of the paediatric wing at RCC in the 1980s, also led the setting up of a Community and Preventive Oncology Department there aiming to create awareness about the disease. He also served as a member of the Expert Advisory Panel of the World Health Organisation (WHO) regarding cancer and the National Cancer Control Plan.

What: Tops the State Energy Efficiency Index 2020

When: published on 29th October 2021

Karnataka has topped the State Energy Efficiency Index 2020 (SEEI), scoring 70 points out of 100 on the back of several initiatives to improve energy efficiency in the state.

The Ministry of Power's (MoP) Energy Efficiency Index ranks states on their performance across 68 indicators covering buildings, industry, municipalities, transport, agriculture, distribution companies (DISCOMs), and cross-sector initiatives. The index assesses the states' performance on policy and regulation, financing mechanism, institutional capacity, adoption of energy efficiency measures, and energy savings.

Karnataka, which has ranked first on the index, took several initiatives to upscale energy efficiency. It carried out an assessment of energy efficiency initiatives across all sectors in the state. The study evaluated the impacts of initiatives on energy savings, economic savings, emission mitigation, social impacts, and utilization of funds. The assessment helped the state provide sufficient data and outcome-based indicators.
