D to B

D: Most of the **students** are not even

B: Aware of the basic **rules of grammar or mathematics**

Connectors:

B to C

B: **Aware of the basic rules** of grammar or mathematics

C: And it **has been proved recently** by the results of

Connectors:

C to A

C: And it has been proved recently **by the results of**

A: **the PISA assessment test** conducted for the junior grade students

The correct sequence is D-B-C-A

This makes option C the right choice among the given options.

2. The opening fragment starts with the status of agriculture in India and the agriculture practices in the country. Among all the given fragments, C is the most suitable connecting fragment as it complements the given part by describing that India is developing alternate techniques for agriculture in India.

Connectors:

C and D

C: Techniques for agriculture **which is mainly**

D: **based on** the natural factors such as rains and heat

Connectors:

D and A

D: based on the natural factors **such as rains and heat**

A: and that is why **the farmers have to suffer** losses

Connectors:

A and B:

A: and that is why **the farmers have to suffer losses**

B: every year **resulting in farmer suicides** across the country

Therefore, the correct sequence is C-D-A-B

So, Option C is the correct choice among the given options.

3. The given fragments are already in proper order and no rearrangement of the fragments of the sentences is required.

This makes Option E the right choice among the given options.

4. The statement is about the status of judiciary in India. Among all the fragments, C fits as the first connecting fragment after the rearrangement.

Connectors:

C and D

C: that most of **the under-trials are made to stay**

D: **inside the prison** for a period far exceeding the period of punishment

Connectors:

D and A

D: Inside the prison for a period far exceeding the period of **punishment**

A: **for the crimes** actually committed by them

Connectors:

A and B

A: for the crimes actually committed by them

B: and it is also the main reason of overcrowding in almost all the prisons in the country

Therefore, the correct sequence of fragments is C-D-A-B

Clearly, Option C is the correct choice.

5. The statement is about the status of various sports in India. The first fragment should be A since it complements the given fragment of the sentence well.

Connectors:

A and D

A: with the Board of Control for Cricket in India being the richest sports body

D: but recently a lot of other sports have become popular

Connectors:

D and C

D: but recently a lot of other sports have become popular

C: also thanks to the premier leagues

Connectors:

C and B

C: also thanks to the premier leagues

B: being organized by the sports federations of all such sports

Therefore, the proper sequence is A-D-C-B

Hence, Option B is the correct choice.

6. The given sentence is perfectly in order and no rearrangement of fragments is required to be carried out in this sentence.

This makes Option E the right choice among the given options.

7. The first fragment

Whether he was a mere frontman

This clearly implies that it should be followed by description of the perception about him being a frontman. This means fragment C should come after the first fragment as it further describes the perception of him being a mere frontman.

Connectors

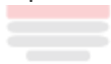
C to B to A

Or a driver of change in an organization
With deep seated prejudices, is difficult to tell;

Only D is left to complete the given sentence.

Hence, the proper sequence of sentences is **CBAD**.

This makes option D the right choice among the given options.



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8. The first fragment

The competition today is talented and runs deep

It implies that the next fragment should give some information regarding the subject which here turns out to be Tiger Wood's performance. Clearly, D fits after the first fragment among the given ones.

Connectors:

D to B to C

And it is important to remember that Woods has 'lost' about a decade of his golfing life
But the next few months will provide the great man the opportunity to demonstrate
That he has truly returned to form and that his run in the PGA.

Only A is left to complete the segment and follow C.

So, the correct sequence of fragments is **DBCA**.

So, Option D is the correct choice among the given options.

9. The first fragment

For the Indian Rupee,

It should be followed by a fragment that says something about the Indian currency or talk about the present situation of the currency in the country. Among the given fragments, Only C will fit in the given context.

Connectors:

C to D to A

Already grappling with high crude oil prices
And the growing heft of the U.S.
Dollar, the latest shock has

Fragment B meaningfully finishes the statement.

So, the correct sequence is **CDAB**

This makes option C the right choice among the given options.



10. The first fragment

With both consumer and wholesale price inflation easing in July,

Clearly, it should be followed by some steps taken by the government or the Reserve Bank of India or the overall picture of the Indian economy in July. Among the given fragments, only A can come next to opening fragment

Connectors

A to D to C

The Reserve Bank of India, which has only intervened
Sparingly in the foreign exchange market so far
May have room to hold off on

Only B will be left to finish the sentence by being placed after C

So, the correct sequence is **ADCB**

Clearly, option B is the correct choice.



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
