Only D is left to complete the statement which ends with the present status of private sector in the development since the role of the public sector has been minimized. This makes the correct sequence of fragments as: **ACBD**

So, option C is the correct choice among the given options.

It should be followed by the details regarding the perception regarding the LGBTQ persons in the society. Among the given fragments, only D can come after this since it takes into consideration the status of the community in the society at present. It should follow the first fragment.

Only fragment A is left to complete the statement which ends with the question regarding the future of the LGBTQ movement in the country in the light of the present situation of the community in the society.

This should be followed by the details regarding the crop and livestock insurance schemes of the country or the requirement of such schemes to change so that they become more useful and effective. Fragment D can be used here in order to imply that the crop and livestock insurance schemes need to be workable and friendlier for the insured so that they may get their claims on time.

Only B is left to complete the statement since that gives the complete information regarding the course of action suggested by the author in the statement.

That makes the correct sequence of the fragment as: **DACB**

This makes option B the correct choice among the given options.

It should be followed by some information regarding such animals or something regarding the killing of such animals in the country. Only D can come here after the first fragment since that describes that killings of such animals took place in certain states of the country.

Only A is left to complete the statement and it is regarding the issue with the killing of the tigers without any proper identification in this regard. This makes the proper sequence as: **DBCA**

This makes option B the correct choice among the given options.

It should be followed by the description regarding what the Supreme Court has in the country and among the given fragments, A can come after the first part since it talks about the history that the Supreme Court has regarding various judgments concerning fundamental rights cases in the country.

Connectors:

D and C:

D: important fundamental rights cases

C: getting recognised much later as

Only B is left that can come at the end of the statement as that describes the history of the SC regarding its minority judgments. This makes the proper sequence of fragments as: **ADCB**.

This makes option C the correct choice among the given options.

It should be followed by something that further describes the significance of the case or else something that can talk about the decision of the apex court in this regard. Only A can come after that since it describes that the Aadhaar hearing took place for 38 days.
