Explanation:

1. Given fragments:

with a shoreline of 110 km (A) / the island is (B) / measuring 40 km by 25 km (C) / roughly circular in shape, (D)

Given options:

DABC:

Roughly circular in shape, with a shoreline of 110 km the island is measuring 40 km by 25 km.

Clearly, the above sentence is ambiguous. Option A can be eliminated here.

DCBA:

Roughly circular in shape, measuring 40 km by 25 km the island is with a shoreline of 110 km.

Clearly, the above sentence is ambiguous too. Option B can be eliminated as well.

BDCA:

The island is roughly circular in shape, measuring 40 km by 25 km with a shoreline of 110 km.

The sentence above is correct both grammatically and contextually.

BACD:

The island is with a shoreline of 110 km measuring 40 km by 25 km roughly circular in shape.

The sentence above is absurd as a line (110 km long) can't have two dimensions. Thus, option D can be eliminated as well.

Clearly, option C is the correct answer.

2. Given fragments:

has seen a surge (A) / of single-use plastics (B) / the Covid-19 pandemic (C) / in the use (D)

Given options:

CDBA:

The Covid-19 pandemic in the use of single-use plastics has seen a surge.

Clearly, the above sentence is ambiguous. Option A can be eliminated here.

CADB:

The Covid-19 pandemic has seen a surge in the use of single-use plastics.

Clearly, the above sentence is both grammatically correct and meaningful.

DBAC:

In the use of single-use plastics has seen a surge the Covid-19 pandemic

Evidently, the sentence above is not at all meaningful. This eliminates option C.

DCAB:

In the use of the Covid-19 pandemic has seen a surge of single-use plastics.

Once again, the sentence is not meaningful and hence option D can be eliminated too.

Option B is hence the correct answer.

3. Given fragments:

CADB:

Smart food choices can bolster immunity belt-tightening times amid a pandemic and.

Clearly, the above sentence is ending with 'and' and hence is not meaningful. Option A can be eliminated here.

CDBA:

Smart food choices belt-tightening times amid a pandemic and can bolster immunity.

Clearly, the above sentence is absolutely absurd and doesn't make any sense. Option B can be eliminated as well.

BCAD:

Amid a pandemic and smart food choices can bolster immunity belt-tightening times.

Once again, the sentence above is poorly structured and doesn't make sense. Option C is eliminated too.

BDCA:

Amid a pandemic and belt-tightening times smart food choices can bolster immunity.

Evidently, the sentence above makes complete sense.

Option D is hence the correct answer.

5. Given fragments:

the Ramayana is a tale (A) / between a rule breaker (B) / and a rule follower (C) of a conflict (D)

Given options:

ADCB:

The Ramayana is a tale of a conflict and a rule follower between a rule breaker.

Clearly, the above sentence doesn't make any sense. Option A can be eliminated here.

ADBC:

The Ramayana is a tale of a conflict between a rule breaker and a rule follower.

Evidently, the sentence above makes complete sense.

BDCA:

Between a rule breaker of a conflict and a rule follower the Ramayana is a tale.

The sentence above is absolutely meaningless. Option C can be eliminated easily.
