Common Explanation (1-5):

The passage seems to be about India representing itself as multi-religious democracy on the global stage and what challenges it faces in realizing that dream. Statement A is fixed as the starting statement and it mentions the claims made by India about itself.

Now, statement D also mentions a dream by the country. The pronoun 'it' used in the statement is used for India and thus, statements A and D are on similar lines and thus, form a pair.

Statement F should be the next in sequence because it mentions 'country with such ambitions' and the ambitions are stated in statement D. This makes ADF a mandatory triplet.

Until now, the passage mentions the aspirations and the portrayal of India but the rest of the statements point out the problems faced. Statement E should come next as it states the problems in realizing the dreams mentioned above to be religious violence, incitement and wrecking of the rule of law. Statement B also states the challenges faced. B must come after E because it mentions 'also'.

Finally, statement C should be the last in the sequence because it mentions that reputation is important for a country and so the efforts of India are justified but apart from that, rule of law is important and it must not be tried to achieve for the sake of reputation.
