## Reference:

Eight people of which A, B, C, and D are women and P, Q, R, and S are men sit around a circular table facing towards the centre.

## Inference:

We draw following circle and put eight marks as chairs as shown.


## Reference:

None of the women sit as immediate neighbour.
$A$ is not facing $B$.

D does not sit second to the right $C$.

## Inference:

We get two cases.

Case-2


Reference:
$Q$, who is immediate neighbour of $C$, faces $P$.

## Inference:

We get four cases as follows.
Case-1
A


Case-2
B


Reference:
$R$ is immediate neighbour of $D$ but not of $C$.

At least one person sits between $A$ and $R$.

Inference:

This will eliminate all the cases except case-1.


1. From final arrangement, we see that $A$ sit to the immediate right of $S$.

Hence, option B is correct.
2. From final arrangement, we see that $C$ sits in front of $B$.

Hence, option B is correct.
3. From final arrangement, we see that $A$ and $B$ both are immediate neighbour of $P$, but only $A$ is given in the options, so we choose the A as immediate neighbour.

Hence, option B is correct.
4. From final arrangement, we see that, only 2 people sit between $R$ and $C$ if counted from right of $R$.

Hence, option D is correct.
5. From final arrangement, we see that, except for the pair $P, S$, all the person on left in the given pair are to the left of second person in the pair.

Hence, option B is correct.

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
