P faces the north and sits at the East end.

Musician faces the same direction as P and sits second to the left of P.

Either Lawyer or Principal is adjacent to Musician (but not both) whose neighbours face south.

Q, a Musician, sits three places away from an Architect and is to the immediate right of K.

K is neither a Principal nor a Lawyer. L and Scientist are neighbours of the Architect.

N who is a Principal sits second to the right of O.

R, a Scientist, is to the immediate left of the Architect and faces south.

M is a professor and sits adjacent to the Scientist. Beautician sits three places away to the right of the Lawyer.

References:

- P faces the north and sits at the right end.
- Musician faces the same direction as P and sits second to the left of P.
- Q, a Musician, sits three places away from an Architect and is to the immediate right of K.
- Either Lawyer or Principal is adjacent to Musician (but not both) whose neighbours face south.

Inferences:

From above statements following arrangement is done:

It is given the neighbours of musician face south.

References:

- L and Scientist are neighbours of the Architect. K is neither a Principal nor a Lawyer.
- R, a Scientist, is to the immediate left of the Architect and faces south.
- M is a professor and sits adjacent to the Scientist.

Inferences:

It is given, L and scientist are neighbours of Architect, and it means architect is in the middle of both. Let's put L and Scientist on either side of Architect, first we will try with Scientist towards the left end and if this possibility gets wrong we will take L towards the left end.

It is also given Scientist i.e. R faces towards south.

And consequently, Architect is facing North direction because it is given R is to the immediate left of Architect.

We also know, M who is a professor sits adjacent to the Scientist. So, M will be at the left end.

- N who is a Principal sits second to the right of O.
- Beautician sits three places away to the right of the Lawyer.

Inferences:

There is only one place vacant where N who is a Principal can be placed which is in between L and Q.

And Beautician sits three places away to the right of the Lawyer. And we know K is not a Lawyer, hence, L will be a Lawyer.

And L will face towards North.

So, finally only thing left is profession of P and that is Teacher.

Already four people are facing North and only three persons are facing South, so M will be facing South.

 Hence, option C is correct.
- 4. It is evident from the diagram that P is a teacher.

 Hence, option B is correct.
- **5.** Clearly, M and P sits at the ends.

Hence, option A is correct.









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
