# Seating Arrangement for SBI Clerk Pre, IBPS Clerk Pre, LIC Assistant and IBPS RRB Exams.

**Directions:** Study the following information carefully and answer the questions given beside.

Eight persons – A, B, C, D, E, F, G and H are sitting around a circular table, but not necessarily in the same order. Four of them are facing inside while rests of them are facing outside.

C is not adjacent to A, who is facing same direction as B. Two persons are sitting between E and G, who are facing different directions. B is sitting fourth to the left of E, who faces centre. E is sitting second to the right of C. Only one person is sitting between A and H, who are facing different directions. F is to the immediate left of H, who is facing same direction as E. D and F are facing same directions.

## Questions :

1. Who among the following faces the same direction?

A. E, B                      B. D, A                      C. H, G                      D. H, F                      E. C, D

2. Four of the following five are alike in a certain way and so form a group. Find the one which does not belong to that group?

A. D                      B. A                      C. E                      D. F                      E. H

3. B is related to H in a certain way; the same way E is related to whom?

4. Who among the following sits second to the right of G?

## Common explanation :

### References:

B is sitting fourth to the left of E, who face centre.

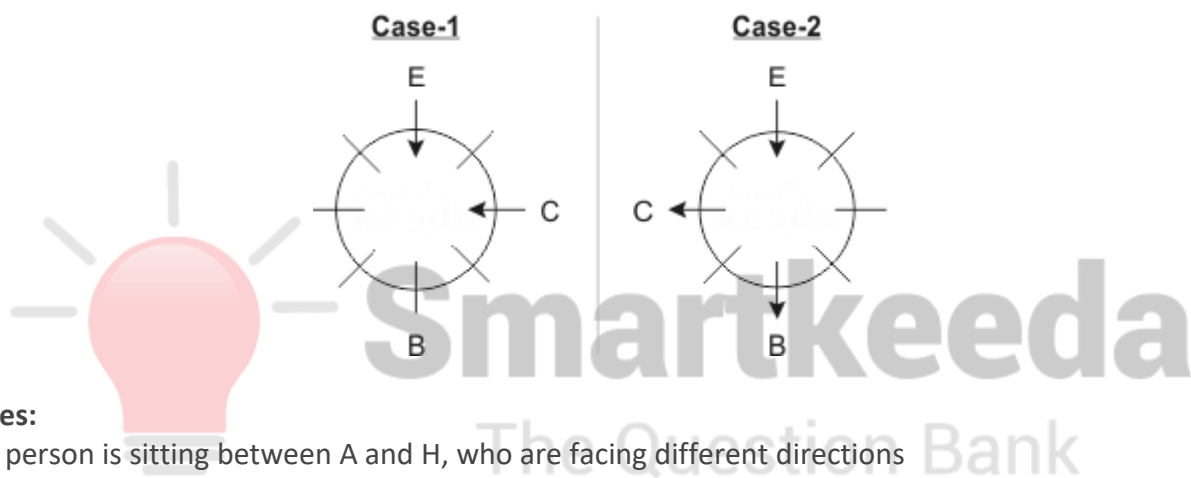
E is sitting second to the right of C.

### Inferences:

There will be two cases Case 1: C is facing the centre.

The other case will be C is facing away from the centre.

Now, we arrange the following Inferences in the circle.



### References:

Only one person is sitting between A and H, who are facing different directions

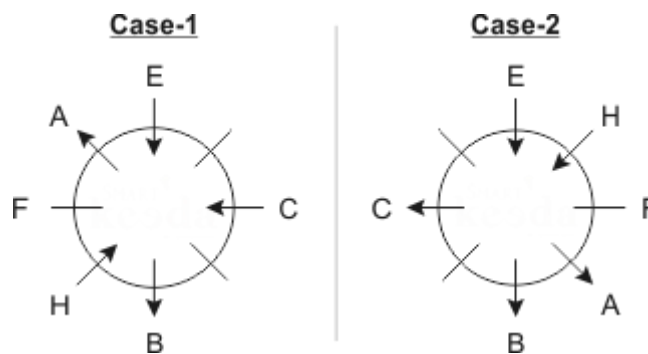
F is to the immediate left of H, who is facing same direction as E.

C is not adjacent to A, who is facing same direction as B

### Inferences:

Hence, Either A and H will face inside or outside.

C will not sit near to A and F will sit immediate left of H.



**References:**

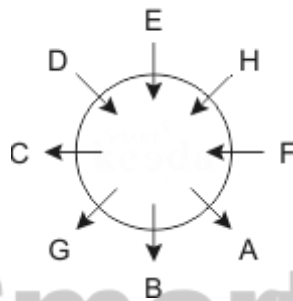
Two persons are sitting between E and G, who are facing different directions.

D and F are facing same directions.

Four of them are facing inside while rests of them are facing outside.

**Inferences:**

The condition mentioned in the references is not possible in case 1 because G will face outside and if D and F are face same direction there will be violation of reference number 3. Hence, case 1 is eliminated.

## Answers:

1. Following the common explanation, H and F face direction.

Hence, option D is the correct answer.

2. Following the common explanation, we can see that, Only A faces outside.

Hence, option B is the correct answer.

3. As per the final solution, B sits third to the left of H in same way E sits third to the left of A.

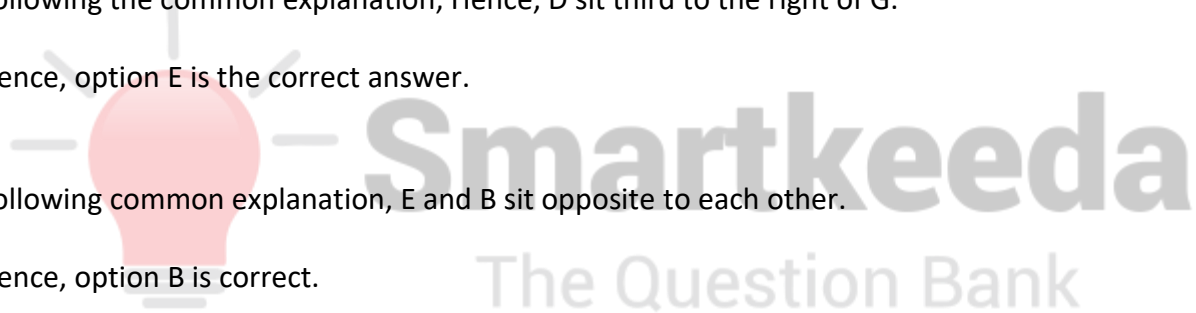
Hence, option E is the correct answer.

4. Following the common explanation, Hence, D sit third to the right of G.

Hence, option E is the correct answer.

5. Following common explanation, E and B sit opposite to each other.

Hence, option B is correct.
