1. • COBOL is a compiled English-like computer programming language designed for business use.

• FORTRAN is a general-purpose, compiled imperative programming language that is especially suited to numeric computation and scientific computing.

• PASCAL is an imperative and procedural programming language intended to encourage good programming practices using structured programming and data structuring.

2. COBOL is an acronym for 'Common Business-Oriented Language'. It is the second-oldest high-level programming language after FORTRAN. It is particularly popular for business applications that run on large computers.

It's a file format used for containing HTML language which constructs a web page. It is based on mark-up codes intended to be used in Web Browsers. HTM contains formatted text, images, and other elements in a way that can be translated with web browsers.

When you request another page from the server, your browser sends the cookie back to the server. It is also known as an HTTP cookie, web cookie, Internet cookie or browser cookie Your browser stores each message in a small file, called cookie.txt

10. A router is a networking device that is used to forward data packets between computer networks. Routers perform the traffic directing functions on the Internet, a data packet is typically forwarded from one router to another router through the networks and it constitute Internet till the packets reach the destination server.
