Reference:
Eight people named from A to H sit along a straight row and are facing north direction.
Inference:
We make following table.
Reference:
Less than two people sit to the left of H.
Inference:
We get two cases depending on if only one person sits to the left of H or no one sit to the left of H.
Case-1 H
Case-2 H
Reference:
G sits in the middle of H and F but is not an immediate neighbour of either of the two.
Inference:
There could be one person between G and H (or F) or two persons.
We get one more case for each of the cases above.
Case-1 H G F
Case-1 (a) H G F



Reference:

D sits immediately between F and A.

Inference:

We get following updates.



Reference:

E is neither an immediate neighbour of G nor of A.

C sits second to the right of B, who is an immediate neighbour of H.

Inference:

We cannot put C as second to the right of B in case-2 (a), thus it gets eliminated.

In case-2, we can put but the E will become an immediate neighbour of A.

In case-1 (a), we can put but then E will become an immediate neighbour of G.

In case-1, we must put B immediately right to H and then E will come at an extreme end.





We get the following final arrangement:

Answers:

1. From final arrangement we see that no one sits to the right of A.

Hence, option E is correct.

2. Only three people sit to the left of G.

Hence, option C is correct.

- 3. From final arrangement we see that F sits to the immediate right of C.

 Hence, option C is correct.
- **4.** We see from final arrangement that 3 people sit between them.

Hence, option D is correct.

Clearly, E is 2nd the left of B and H is 2nd to the left of G. Similarly, F is 2nd to the left of A.
Hence, option C is correct.
