Explanations:

1. **Statement I** As the Government of India has decided to go ahead with a 20-year blueprint for development, the Five Year Planning has been done away with in India.

It is correct since it connects both the statements meaningfully.

Statement II is not correct since the reason of cancellation of the Five Year Planning is the new plan of the government of going ahead with a 20-year blueprint and not the other way around as has been implied in the given statement.

Statement III is not correct since it does not connect the two sentences meaningfully.

So, option B is the correct choice.

2. **Statement I** That the Supreme Court has made it clear that only long term motor insurance policies will be there in India will make all the insurance companies issue such policies.

This is correct since both the sentences are connected meaningfully.

Statement II As the Supreme Court has made it clear that only long term motor insurance policies will be there in India, it will make all the insurance companies issue policies for long term.

This is correct since the combined sentence makes a meaningful and contextually correct statement.

Statement III is not correct because the sentence connector used is 'yet' which implies in spite of something. It is not fit for the given context as here the insurance companies are going to abide by the Supreme Court ruling and there is no space for neglecting the same on the part of the insurance companies.

Hence, only I and II make meaningful and contextually correct sentence when combined.

This makes option B the correct choice among the given options.

- 3. Statement I** As many students are now very concerned about the environment, it is a good sign for the country as well as the society.

This is correct since both the statements are connected meaningfully.

Statement II That many students are now very concerned about the environment is a good sign for the country as well as the society.

This is also correct since both the statements are connected meaningfully.

Statement III is not correct since the connector is used is not correct. 'Though' is used to denote that despite of something it is taking place. In this context, it will not be applicable.

Hence, only I and II are correct as the combined statements in these two cases make meaningful and contextually correct sentences.

So, option E is the right choice.

- 4. Statement I** is not correct since the connector used here is 'since' which is used in case of cause and effect relationship between two statements. In the given statement, there is no such relationship between the two sentences as one is about an initiative of the government and the other is about the same subject with more details only.

Statement II is not correct because 'while' is used to denote that something is taking place while something else is also happening. In the given statement, 'while' will not fit in the context as the sentences are mere descriptions regarding the same subject and there is no reference to any activity being carried out simultaneously with another.

Statement III is also incorrect since with the given beginning, it is not possible to connect the two sentences. 'Hardly _____when' is used to denote barely or unlikely. It does not fit in the given context and will not make meaningful statement when combined.

So, none of the given choices will make the combined statement meaningful as well as contextually correct.

This makes option E the right choice among the given options.

5. **Statement I** is incorrect since the reason that the Police are not going to adopt a law will not make it ineffective. The Police have to take cognizance of the law and it is not their prerogative to judge any law passed by the Parliament. These two statements given cannot share the cause and effect relationship required for connecting them with the given connector 'since'.

Statement II is not correct since there should be cause and effect relationship between the given statements in order to connect them with the given connector 'as'. In these sentences, no such relationship is there because a law cannot be ineffective if the Police are not practicing it but they have to abide by it. Had it been the case that the law cannot be implemented, it would have been ineffective as stated in the sentences but so is not the case in this context.

Statement III is also incorrect because it is completely out of context to even think about connecting the given two statements with the connector 'scarcely' which actually implies *barely*. It has no bearing on the given two statements as far as connecting them is concerned.

Hence, none of the given choices will be correct in the given context.

This makes option E the correct choice among the given options.

6. **Statement I** Since the government has set the treatment of solid waste as a criterion for ranking cities, the Municipal Corporation has decided to start a waste treatment plant for the solid waste.

This is correct as both the sentences are connected in a meaningful manner.

Statement II The government having set the treatment of solid waste as a criterion for ranking cities, the Municipal Corporation has decided to start a waste treatment plant for the solid waste.

This is correct as both the sentences are connected in a meaningful manner.

Statement III The Municipal Corporation has decided to start a waste treatment plant for the solid waste as the government has set the treatment of solid waste as a criterion for ranking cities.

It is also correct since both the sentences are connected in a meaningful manner

Hence, option E is the correct choice among the given options.

7. **Statement I** is not correct since with that beginning it is not possible to connect the two sentences in the meaningful manner

Statement II is not correct since no meaningful statement can be formed with the given beginning. It is not possible to combine the given two sentences without altering their meanings if we begin with the given phrase.

Statement III The Make in India program launched by the government on the occasion of the Independence Day this year is not giving desired response to the government from the private sector.

It also connects two sentences in a meaningful manner and that is why it is correct.

This makes option A the right choice among the given options.



8. **Statement I** Though the Supreme Court has ruled that the insurance companies should start selling long-term insurance policies, all the insurance companies have not complied with the order till date.

This is correct since both the statements are connected meaningfully.

Statement II Here we are talking about two sentences that denote contrasting stands. It is expected that after the SC ruling, the insurance companies will comply with the order of the apex court but that has not taken place till date. As is mainly used to combine two sentences which denote the cause and effect relationship. This is hence not correct.

Statement III Despite the Supreme Court having ruled that the insurance companies should start selling long-term insurance policies, all the insurance companies have not complied with the order till date.

This is also correct as a combined statement.

So, option D is the right choice.

- 9. Statement I** With the mentality of the players having changed a lot now, the Indian cricket team has started winning matches outside the subcontinent.

This is correct since both the sentences are connected meaningfully.

Statement II As the mentality of the players has changed a lot now, the Indian cricket team has started winning matches outside the subcontinent.

This is also correct since with the given beginning, a sentence can be combined that will be meaningful and also contextually correct without altering the meaning of the separate sentences.

Statement III With *although*, it is not possible to combine statements which are actually related by the cause and effect relationship. *Although* is mainly used to combine two contrasting statements. Hence, this should not be considered as correct.

Hence, option C is the correct choice.

- 10. Statement I** It cannot be considered as true since the given statements are not connected by the relationship of cause and effect between them. *Since* is used for that purpose only and that is why, this cannot be considered as a correct combination of two sentences.

Statement II It is also not the correct choice since with this beginning; the statements cannot be combined to form a single sentence without any change in the meaning of the separate sentences.

Statement III It is not even relevant in this context since it is used to connect contrasting sentences and the given sentences are certainly not contrasting to each other.

This makes option E the correct choice among the given options.



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
