Explanations:

1. Checking A-D:

The real solution that will help is to replace all or most subsidies its role as the driving force of nature.

The sentence doesn't make any sense. The pair A-D is hence invalid.

Checking A-F:

The real solution that will help is to replace all or most subsidies with income support to farmers, directly transferred to their accounts.

The above sentence is correct both grammatically and contextually.

Checking B-D:

Ancient civilisations revered water, acknowledging its role as the driving force of nature.

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The above sentence too is correct both grammatically and contextually.

Checking C-E:

The drug menace in Punjab is an issue that is to be dealing with immediately.

The above sentence is incorrect. Instead of 'dealing with', 'dealt with' would have been correct here. Hence, pair C-D is invalid.

Option C is hence the correct answer.

2. Checking B-D:

State owned educational facilities needs a digital makeover.

Here, the plural subject 'facilities' should be followed by the plural verb 'need' instead of singular 'needs'. The pair B-D is hence invalid.

Checking C-E:

Digital dementia is a real mental condition arising due to over-dependency on technology.

The above sentence is correct both grammatically and contextually.

Checking A-F:

The staff should be encouraged to use inexpensive reusable plastic bags when possible and refuse plastic in most cases.

The above sentence too is correct both grammatically and contextually. Hence, the pair A-F is valid.

Option C is hence the correct answer.

3. Checking C-D:

They are ignorant of the fact that happiness can be found not in consuming recklessly and in giving back to nature.

The sentence is grammatically incorrect. The conjunction 'but' should have been used instead of 'and' in order to make the sentence correct.

Checking A-E:

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Zonal councils provide common meeting ground for states to facilitate co-ordinated efforts for fostering economic and social development.

The above sentence is correct both grammatically and contextually.

Checking B-F:

The decision will make ocean energy eligible for meeting the non-solar Renewable Purchase Obligations.

The above sentence is correct both grammatically and contextually.

Option D is hence the correct answer.

The above sentence is correct both grammatically and contextually.

Checking C-D:

The above sentence too is correct both grammatically and contextually.

Option D is hence the correct answer.

5. Checking A-D:

UDAY Express is a specially-designed double decker air conditioned train and travel abroad without permission from a male guardian.

The above sentence does not make any sense and is incorrect.

Checking C-D:

The expedition team is not allowed to take any photos of any installations without consent and also will have to limit itself to approved routes.

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The above sentence is correct both grammatically and contextually.

Checking A-E:

UDAY Express is a specially-designed double decker air conditioned train with chair car coaches primarily allocated to routes with heavy passenger traffic.

The above sentence too is correct both grammatically and contextually.

Checking B-F:

AWHO will now facilitate acquisition of homes from reputed and travel abroad without permission from a male guardian.

The above sentence does not make any sense and is incorrect.

Option C is hence the correct answer.

7. Checking A-F:

Artificial Intelligence may be the great buzzword of our times and Machine Learning is really the brass tacks.

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Here, as the sentence implies contrast in ideas usage of the conjunction 'and' is absurd. Instead of 'and' 'but' should have been used. Hence, the sentence doesn't make any sense. The pair A-F is hence invalid.

Checking C-D:

The book chronicles spiritual and educational pursuits of a woman who takes up writing as a mode of self-examination.

The above sentence is correct both grammatically and contextually.

Checking B-F:

High MSP for rice and wheat, in combination with subsidised inputs and credit, has resulted in unwanted stocks of these grains in government godowns.

The above sentence is grammatically incorrect. There are two subjects 'high MSP' and 'subsidised inputs' whereas singular verb 'has' has been used instead of plural 'have'.

Checking A-E:

Insolvency courts must get their act together to make the bankruptcy code work for swiftly resolution of corporate distress.

The above sentence too is incorrect grammatically. The adjective 'swift' should have been used instead of the adverb 'swiftly'.

Option A is hence the correct answer.

The above sentence is correct both grammatically and contextually.

Checking B-F:

Checking C-D:

The legends of the lost civilization tell tales of bewitching objects and lost treasures.

Option C is hence the correct answer.
