The above sentence too is correct both grammatically and contextually.

Option C is hence the correct answer.

The comparative degree should have been used instead of superlative since a comparison 'between' two people has been made. 'Taller' should replace 'tallest' so as to make the sentence correct. The pair C-D is hence invalid.

The above sentence is correct both grammatically and contextually.

Checking A-E:

India has traditionally been known for leadership in education and teacher preparation.

The above sentence too is correct both grammatically and contextually. Hence, the pair A-E is valid.
