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Explanations:

1. <u>Connectors:</u>

A and E:

These two fragments can be connected together in order to form a complete sentence that will be meaningful and grammatically correct as well.

The sentence would be:

It is not wrong to declare the orientation of a person in front of everyone without shame.

B - F:

These two can also be connected in order to form a complete sentence that will be meaningful and grammatically correct.

The complete sentence would be:

The decision of the government is going to hurt the sentiments of the people there but it was necessary.

C - D:

These two statements can also be connected so that a complete sentence can be formed that will be meaningful and grammatically correct.

The complete sentence would be:

It should not be borne in mind that you are not being given chances but you should utilize everything.

This makes Option A the correct choice among the given options.

2. None of the given pairs can be connected together in order to frame grammatically and meaningfully correct statement.

This makes Option E the correct choice among the given options.



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3. Checking A-E:

There is no relation with into the irregularity in the commitment of the assembly there.

The above sentence makes no sense at all. Options A and D get eliminated.

Checking C-D:

There are so many issues being faced by people from around the globe that the world leaders should immediately sit down and discuss them.

The above sentence is correct both grammatically and contextually. Hence, C-D is a valid combination.

This makes Option B the correct choice among the given options.

4. Checking AE: The monsoon is yet to come to India though it has already made inroads in the neighbouring countries.

The above sentence is correct both grammatically and contextually. Combination AE, hence, is a valid one.

Checking BF: The industrial production is not going to suffer the agriculture sector is registering growth year after year.

The above sentence seems contextually correct but it is not correct grammatically. A conjunction 'as/since' must be used to link the two given clauses. Combination BF, hence, is invalid.

Checking CD: There are so many things that should be discussed in the summit to address the concerns.

The above sentence is correct both grammatically and contextually. Combination CD, hence, is a valid one.

Clearly, option B is the correct answer.

5. Evidently, none of the pairs will be perfect to be connected together in order to form a meaningful and grammatically correct sentence.

This makes Option E the correct choice among the given options.

6. The correctly matched pairs are AE, BF and CD. A mentions officials of a particular country, so it should be completed by a sentence which has some specific 'national importance' information. So A is completed by E. B starts with a police action so it must be against a domestic level crime hence F would be the right option. C & D together make sense.

Hence, option E is the right answer.

7. The correctly matched pairs are AE and BF. C from column 1 does not complete any sentence meaningfully hence it is ruled out. Same is the case of D from column 2. B mentions a scientific discovery so it should be something which does not exist already. Hence F completes B.

A does not match with D but it makes sense when matched with E, as a regiment is a unit of military force so missile from E follows.

Hence option D is the right answer.

8. The correctly matched pairs are AD, BF and CE. To curb or to stop criminal activities installing CCTV cameras to keep a check on unwanted activity seems the right course of action. Hence A goes with D. 'Bonanza' is a situation which creates a sudden increase in wealth while 'serendipity' means the occurrence and development of events by chance in a happy or beneficial way. Thus F completes B. C & E is an easy guess and they are a correct match too.

Hence option A is the right answer.

9. The correctly matched pairs are AF, BD and CE. Monsoon and rainfall would fit together so A goes with F. Clean fuel would obviously cause less pollution hence B matches D. Issues with traffic matches option E from column 2 which states 'paucity' or shortage of parking bays as an issue.

Hence option C is the right answer.

A starts with 'more than' which is a comparative phrase, so it should follow with, difference between two things but no such option is available so we can safely assume that A does not have a match. 'Whopping' means enormous or very large, after looking at column 2 we see that only D matches the description of amount in Crores which is huge. Hence B goes with D. C & E individually appear to be different sentences but when read together make sense, hence C goes with E.

Hence option B is the right answer.





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
