Who: Union govt

What: agrees to rename railway station after Siddharoodha seer

When: published on 11th September 2020

The Union government has approved the long-pending demand of Hubballi resident to rename the Hubballi railway station after Shree Siddharoodha Swamiji.

Lalita T Hedaoo, undersecretary to the government of India, ministry of home affairs, has stated in a letter addressed to the principal secretary to the government, revenue department, Karnataka, that the Union government has no objection to rename 'Hubballi Railway Station' as 'Shree Siddharoodha Swamiji Railway Station Hubballi'. She has referred the letter of chief minister BS Yediyurappa dated November 22, 2019. (Read more)

What: sign key pact for reciprocal provision of supplies, services between defence forces

When: published on 10th September 2020

India and Japan have signed a key agreement for reciprocal provision of supplies and services between their defence forces, which is expected to drive closer military cooperation and contribute to regional security.

The Acquisition and Cross-Servicing Agreement (ACSA) between Japan's Self-Defense Forces and India's armed forces was signed by Japanese ambassador Satoshi Suzuki and defence secretary Ajay Kumar in New Delhi on Wednesday.

"The agreement establishes a framework such as the settlement procedures for the reciprocal provision of supplies and services between the Self-Defense Forces of Japan and the Indian armed forces," said a statement from Japan's foreign ministry. (Read more)

What: Hold First Trilateral Dialogue With Focus On Indo-Pacific

When: published on 9th September 2020

India, Australia and France on Wednesday held talks for the first time under a trilateral framework with focus on enhancing cooperation in the Indo-Pacific, a region that has been witnessing increasing Chinese military assertiveness.

The virtual meeting was co-chaired by foreign secretary Harsh Vardhan Shringla, secretary-general Francois Delattre from the French ministry for Europe and foreign affairs, and Australian foreign affairs secretary Frances Adamson.

"The focus of the dialogue was on enhancing cooperation in the Indo-Pacific Region," the external affairs ministry said in a statement. (Read more)

4. Hints to Remember

Who: More than 3 billion people

What: protected from harmful trans fat in their food

When: published on 9th September 2020

Two years into the World Health Organization's (WHO) ambitious effort to eliminate industrially produced trans fats from the global food supply, the Organization reports that 58 countries so far have introduced laws that will protect 3.2 billion people from the harmful substance by the end of 2021. But more than 100 countries still need to take actions to remove these harmful substances from their food supplies.

Consumption of industrially produced trans fats are estimated to cause around 500,000 deaths per year due to coronary heart disease.

"In a time when the whole world is fighting the COVID-19 pandemic, we must make every effort to protect people's health. That must include taking all steps possible to prevent noncommunicable diseases that can make them more susceptible to the coronavirus, and cause premature death," said WHO Director-General Dr Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus. "Our goal of eliminating trans fats by 2023 must not be delayed." (Read more)

Who: WWF Living Planet Report 2020

What: reveals 68% drop in wildlife populations

When: published on 10th September 2020

The thirteenth edition of WWF's biennial flagship publication gives an overview of the state of the natural world through the Living Planet Index (LPI), which tracked almost 21,000 populations of more than 4,000 vertebrate species between 1970 and 2016.

The LPI revealed a 68% average decline in global vertebrate species populations between 1970 and 2016.

Wildlife populations found in freshwater habitats fell by 84% - the starkest average population decline in any biome, equivalent to 4% per year since 1970. (Read more)

What: unveils Doorstep Banking Services and declares EASE 2.0 Index Results

When: published on 9th September 2020

EASE Reforms Index has equipped Boards and leadership for effective governance, instituted risk appetite frameworks, created technology- and data-driven risk assessment and prudential underwriting and pricing systems, introduced Early Warning Signals (EWS) systems and specialised monitoring for time-bound action in respect of stress, put in place focussed recovery arrangements, and established outcome-centric HR systems.

What: Launches Central Bank Digital Currencies (CBDCs) Testing Platform, Enabling Central Banks to Assess and Explore National Digital Currencies

When: published on 9th September 2020



With the global economy racing to embrace digital payments, central banks also are looking to the future and investigating how to support innovation while maintaining monetary policy and financial stability as they issue and distribute currency. In fact, 80 percent of central banks surveyed are engaging in some form of Central Bank Digital Currencies (CBDCs) work, and about 40 percent of central banks have progressed from conceptual research to experimenting with concept and design, according to a recent survey by the Bank for International Settlements.

Today, Mastercard announced a proprietary virtual testing environment for central banks to evaluate CBDC use cases. The platform enables the simulation of issuance, distribution and exchange of CBDCs between banks, financial service providers and consumers. Central banks, commercial banks, and tech and advisory firms are invited to partner with Mastercard to assess CBDC tech designs, validate use cases and evaluate interoperability with existing payment rails available for consumers and businesses today. What: launches collateral free line of credit for SMEs

When: published on 8th September 2020

The pandemic has not only knocked off revenues of MSMEs' but also disturbed their hopes of survival. In a bid to rescue MSMEs and improve their cash flows, Razorpay has launched a collateral free line of credit called Cash Advance. MSMEs can borrow working capital with a credit limit of Rs 50,000 to Rs



10 lakh, within 10 seconds through the Razorpay dashboard, depending upon the credit history of the business.

Global analytics company CRISIL found that during these downturns, micro and small enterprises are unable to manage working capital challenges as easily as their large and medium peers. India has more than 63 million MSMEs, 40% of these have availed loans from formal channels like banks and lending institutions while 60% don't have easy access to working capital loans. While the government continues to offer schemes that will benefit MSMEs, most of them have only been able to partially take advantage of it, primarily because accessibility of such services is based on collateral, size, vintage and credit history of business. Also, under these schemes, businesses are required to be qualified as an MSME, as defined by the government to avail loans from banks. (Read more)

Electro Solaire (ESPL), a special purpose vehicle owned by the ENGIE Group, will implement the project.

ADB, along with another international lender, will provide the entire debt required to construct the solar power plant, the statement said.

ESPL is collaborating with the Gujarat government to construct the project and has signed a power purchase agreement (PPA) for 25 years with the state government. (Read more)
