Who: ADB, Suguna

What: Sign \$15 Million Deal to Sustain Rural Livelihoods in India During Pandemic

When: published on 11th September 2020

The Asian Development Bank (ADB) has signed an agreement for \$15 million of debt financing through the subscription of nonconvertible debentures for Suguna Foods Private Limited (Suguna), in equivalent Indian rupees, to help sustain poultry farming operations, as well as rural livelihoods and food security in India during the coronavirus disease (COVID-19) pandemic.

The agreement was signed by Deputy Director General at ADB's Private Sector Operations Department Mr. Christopher Thieme and Suguna Foods Private Limited Managing Director G.B. Sundararajan. (Read more)

Who: RBI

What: lays down guidelines for banks to appoint chief compliance officers

When: published on 11<sup>th</sup> September 2020

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) on Friday laid down guidelines for appointment of chief compliance officer (CCO) in banks to ensure uniform approach with regard to compliance and risk management culture across the banking industry. According to an RBI circular, the CCO should be appointed for a minimum fixed period of three years in the rank of a general manager or not below two levels of the rank of CEO.

"Such an independent compliance function is required to be headed by a designated CCO selected through a suitable process with an appropriate 'fit and proper' evaluation/selection criteria to manage compliance risk effective," the RBI said. (Read more)

What: joins chipmaker Nvidia partner network for AI opportunities

Information technology (IT) services firm HCL Technologies announced on Friday that it is joining chipmaker Nvidia's partner network (NPN) to pursue expanded opportunities in artificial intelligence (AI) space.

The Noida-headquartered firm has also launched an AI lab to enhance capabilities in the space.

Called NEXT.ai, the AI lab will focus on upskilling engineers and architects utilising AI solutions across hardware and software technology stacks. The company said that this will enhance their capabilities to build AI-led solutions for multiple HCL clients across industry verticals. (Read more)

What: projects 11.5% contraction in India's economic growth in FY21

When: published on 11<sup>th</sup> September 2020

Ratings agency Moody's on Friday projected 11.5% contraction in India's economic growth in the current fiscal owing to coronvirus pandemic, from (-) 4 per cent estimated earlier.

"India's credit profile increasingly constrained by low growth, high debt burden and a weak financial system," said Moody's.

India's policymaking institutions have struggled to mitigate, contain risks exacerbated by Covid-19, the ratings agency said.

Risks from deeper stresses in Indian economy, financial system can lead to fiscal strength erosion, said Moody's. (Read more)

What: becomes first Indian company to have a market capitalisation of \$200 billion

When: published on 10<sup>th</sup> September 2020

Reliance Industries on Thursday (September 10) became the first Indian company to have a market capitalisation of more than \$200 billion after its shares touched a record high of Rs 2,344.95, up over 8%. Investors turned bullish on the stock after the Mukesh Ambani-led conglomerate raised Rs 7,500



crore from US private equity investor Silver Lake by selling 1.75% stake in Reliance Retail Ventures Ltd (RRVL), the holding company of its retail assets.

At the day's highest points of Rs 2,344.95, RIL's marketcapitalisation stood at Rs 14.70 lakh crore while the market value of its partly paid rights shares rose to Rs 58,800 cror, taking the combined market capitalisation of RIL to Rs 15.28 lakh crore or \$208 billion. (Read more)

What: Approves Acquisition of Piramal Pharma's 20% Stakes Acquisition by CA Clover Intermediate

Competition Commission of India (CCI) approves proposed combination involving acquisition of 20% of the issued and paid-up equity share capital of Piramal Pharma Limited (Pharma Co.) by CA Clover Intermediate II Investments (Curie).

The proposed combination relates to (i) the transfer of global pharmaceutical business (Transferred Business) by Piramal Enterprises Limited (PEL) to a wholly-owned subsidiary of PEL, i.e. Pharma Co., followed by, (ii) the acquisition of 20% of the issued and paid-up equity share capital of Pharma Co. by Curie (Proposed Combination). (Read more)

Who: National Forest Martyrs Day 2020

What: was observed on 11<sup>th</sup> September 2020

National Forest Martyrs Day is observed in India on September 11 every year to remember the sacrifice of those who laid their lives to protect the forests and wildlife across the remote corners of the country.

The Ministry of Environment and Forest made the declaration in 2013 and since then, people across India observe National Forest Martyrs Day every year on September 11 to pay tributes to the valour and sacrifice made the forest personnel to protect the forests and wildlife of India.

The National Forest Martyrs Day is observed to commemorate the Khejarli massacre, which took place on September 11 in 1730. During the massacre, Rajasthan's Maharaja Abhay Singh started cutting the Khejarli trees, which were considered as a sacred tree in the Bishnoi community in Khejarli village in Rajasthan.

A woman, reportedly named Amrita Devi stood up in resistance and offered her head instead of Khejarli trees. The army of Abhay Singh beheaded her and her three daughters who stood up in resistance after their mother. The decapitation continued with 359 more men from the Bishnoi community beheaded by the army before the news of the massacre reached the king himself.

When Abhay Singh heard the dreadful news, he immediately ordered his men to stop the cutting of the trees and honoured the courage of the Bishnoi community. The King also apologised to the community and issued a decree engraved on a copper plate to prohibit the cutting of Khejarli trees and hunting of animals within and near Bishnoi villages forever.
